

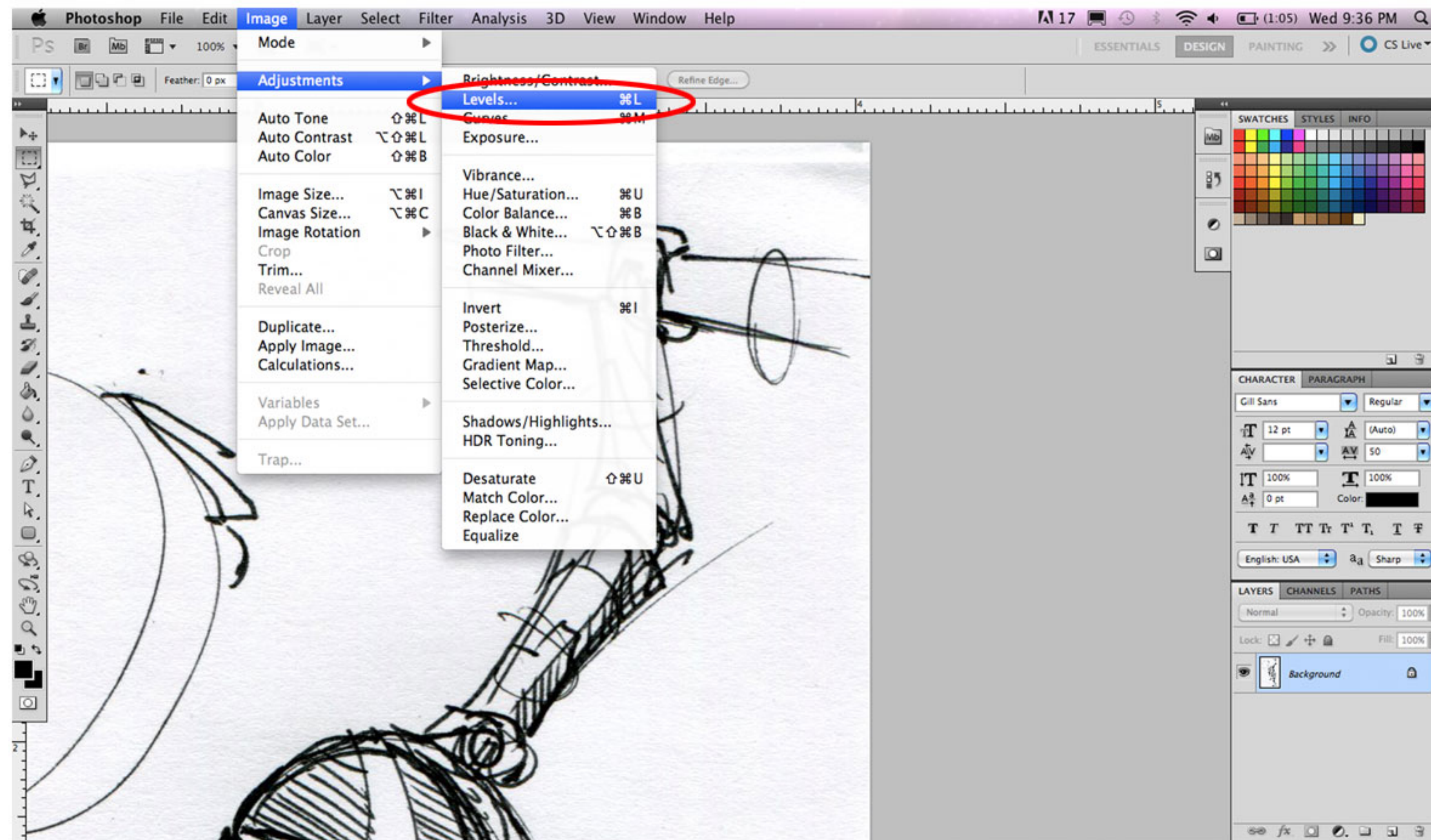
Step 1:

Bring scanned image into PS



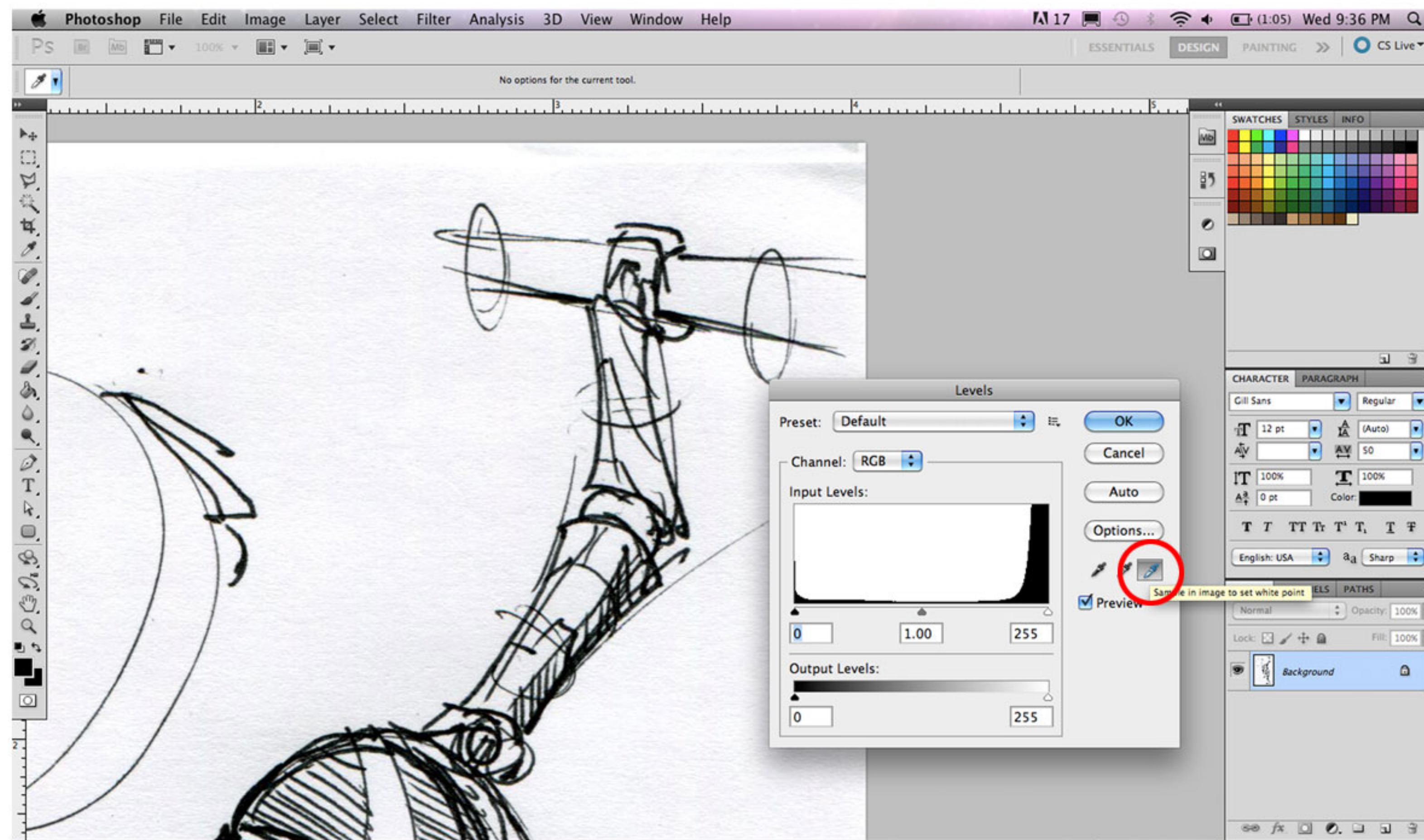
Step 2:

Open the levels menu (Ctrl+L)



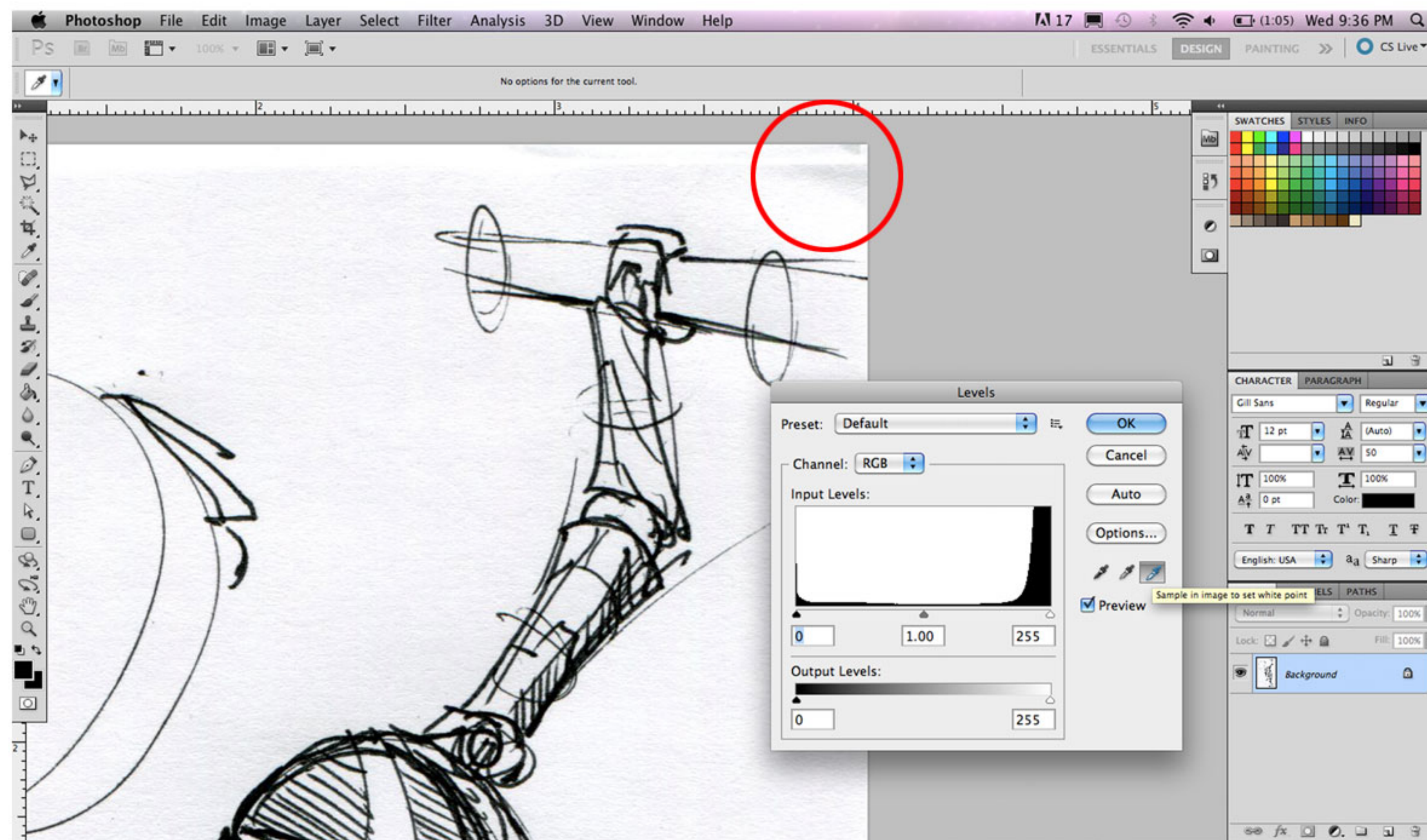
Step 3:

Click on the third eye drop tool



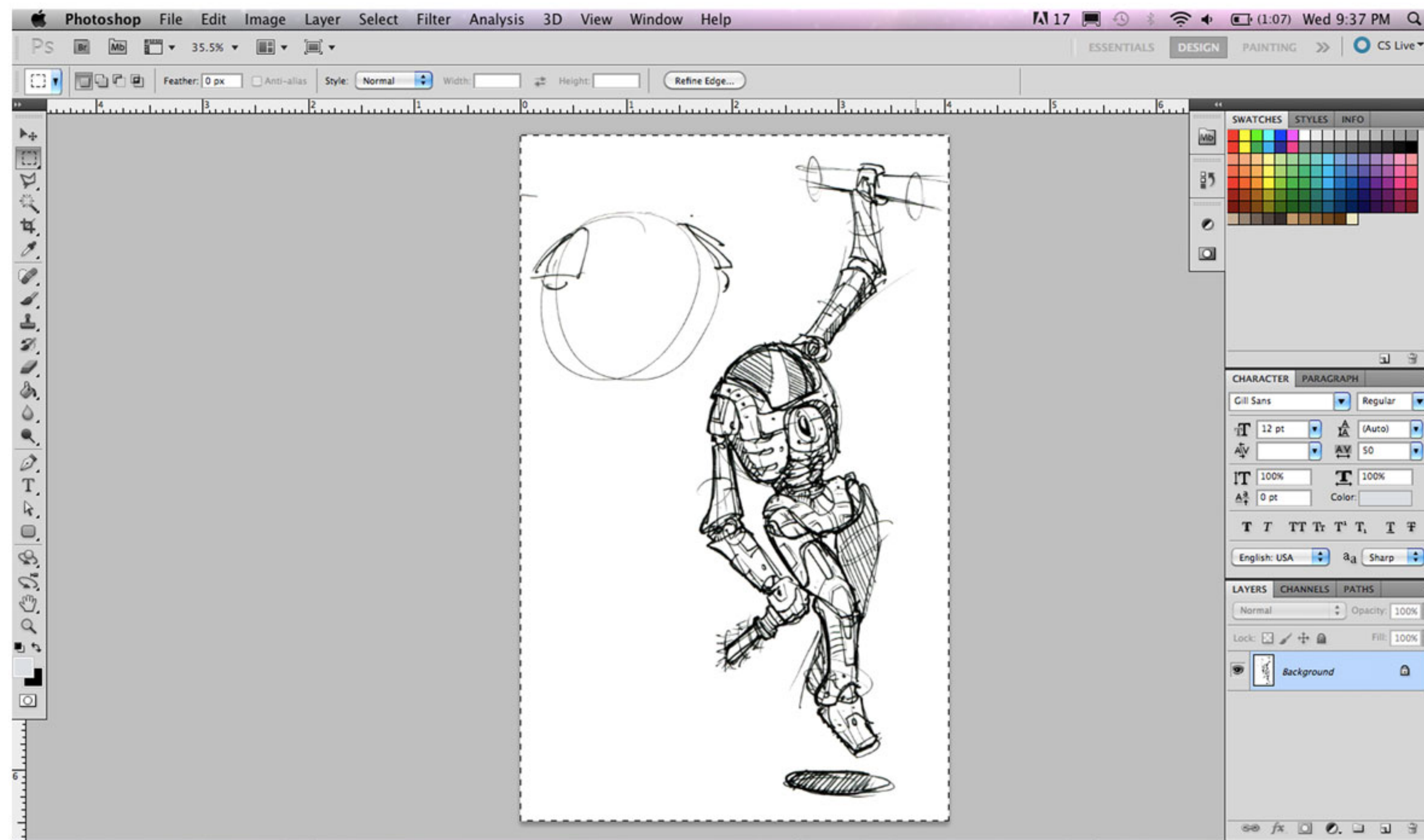
Step 4:

Click on the dirtiest area of the scanned image (If there are any remaining dirty areas, just click on that area to remove it)



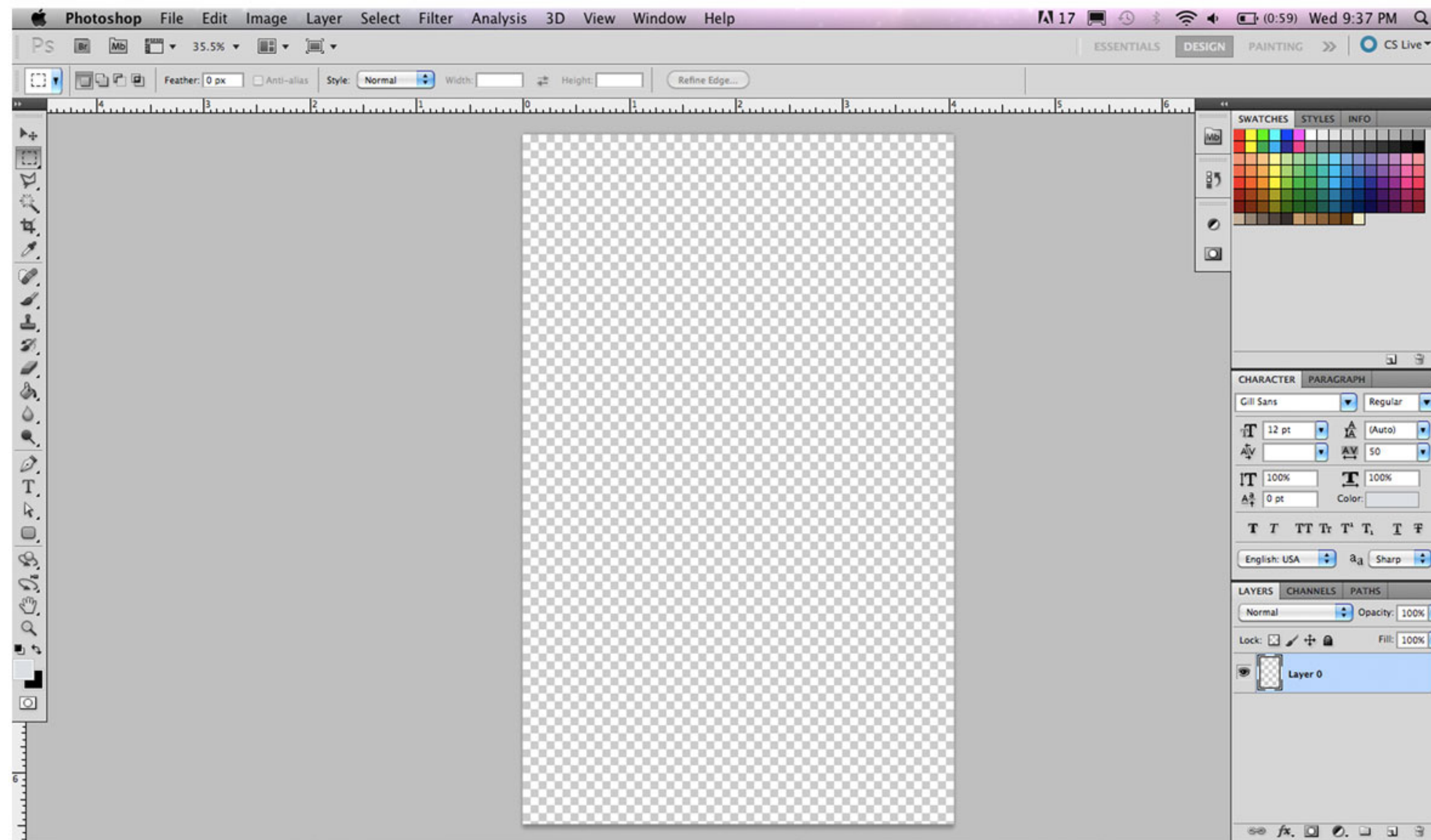
Step 5:

Select All
(Ctrl+A)



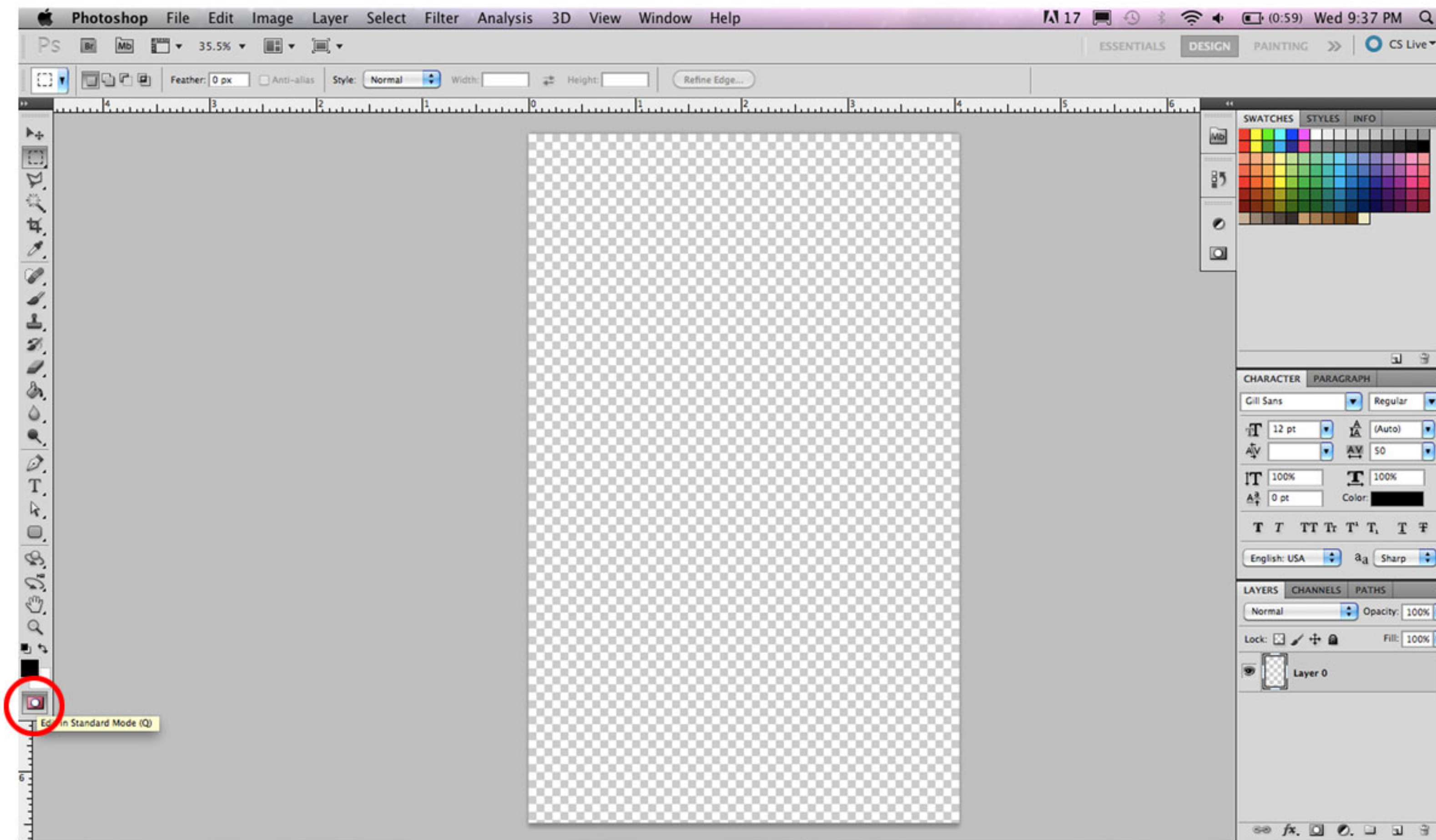
Step 6:

Cut out the
entire area
(Ctrl+X)



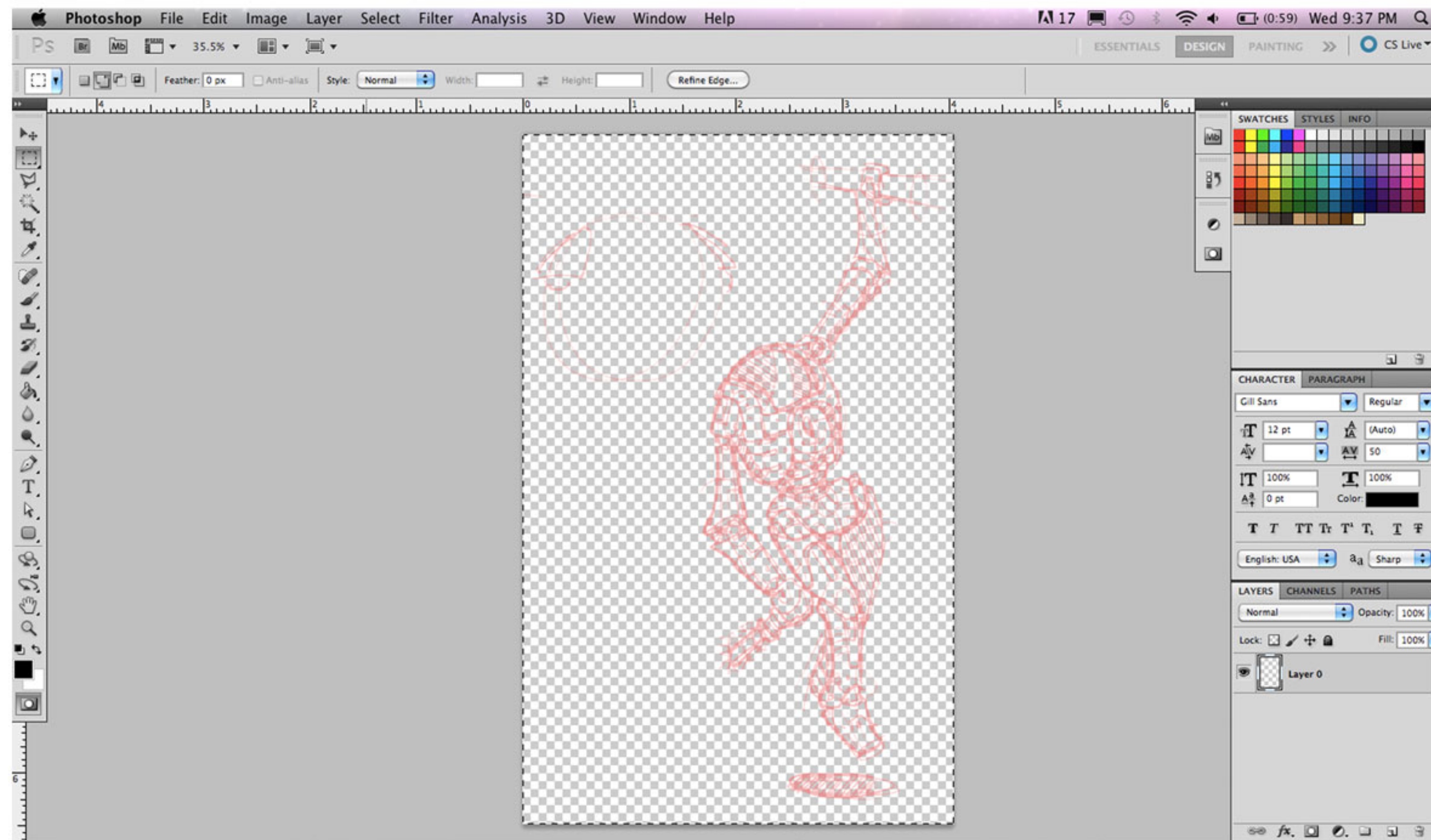
Step 7:

Press the quick mask button (Q)



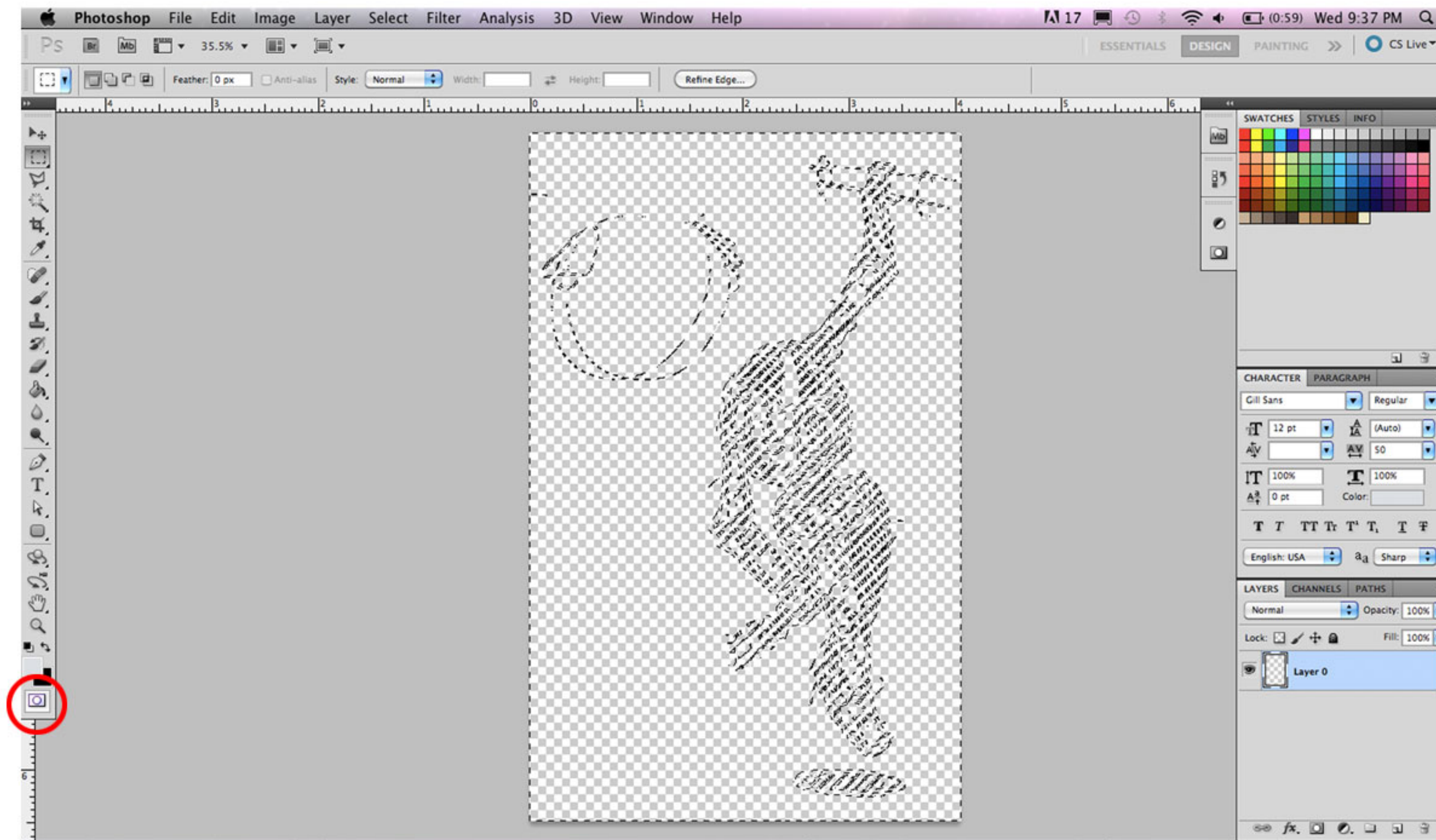
Step 8:

Paste back into the layer (Ctrl+V)



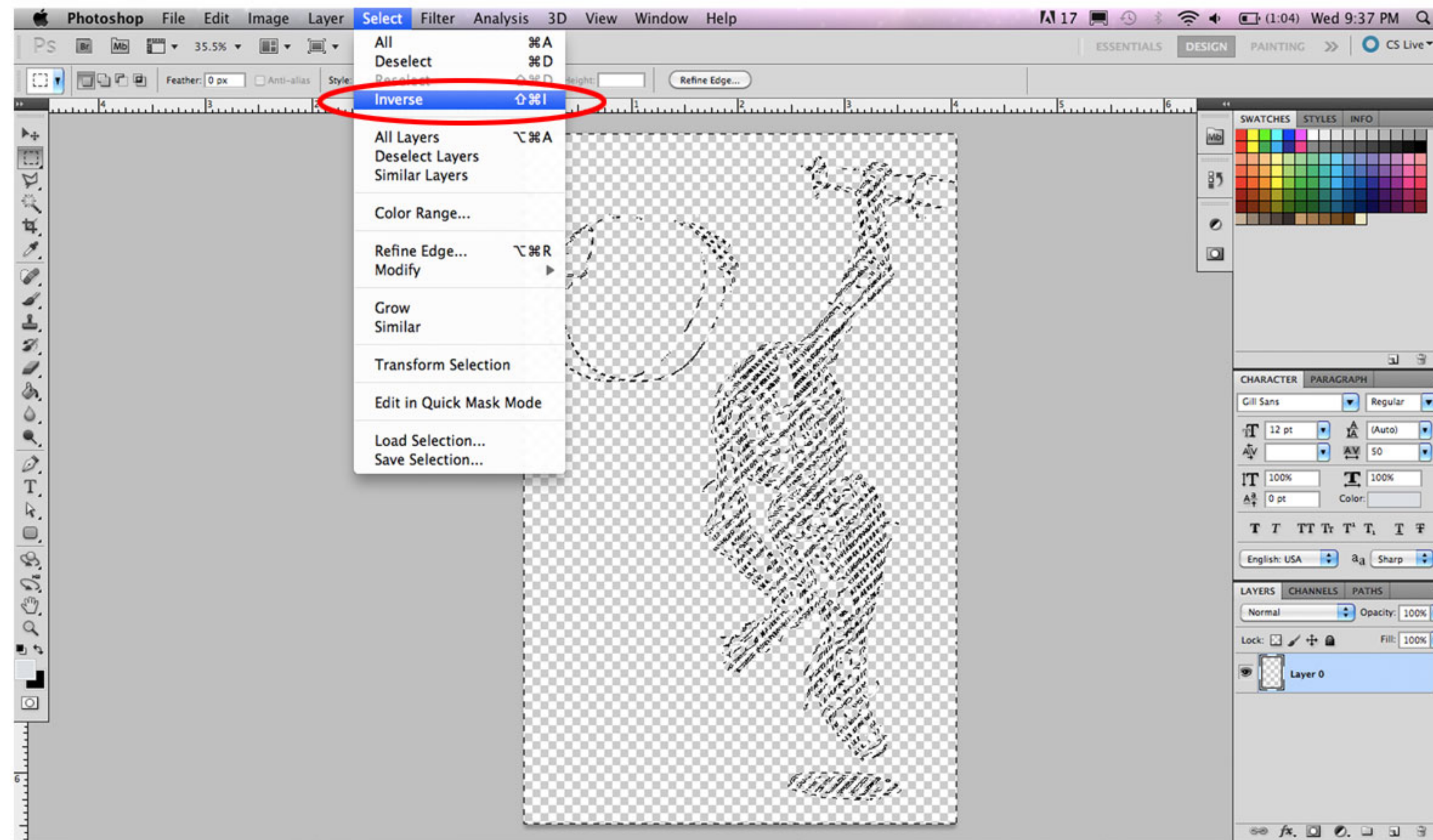
Step 9:

Turn off
quick mask mode
(Q)



Step 10:

Inverse your
selection
(Ctrl+Shift+I)



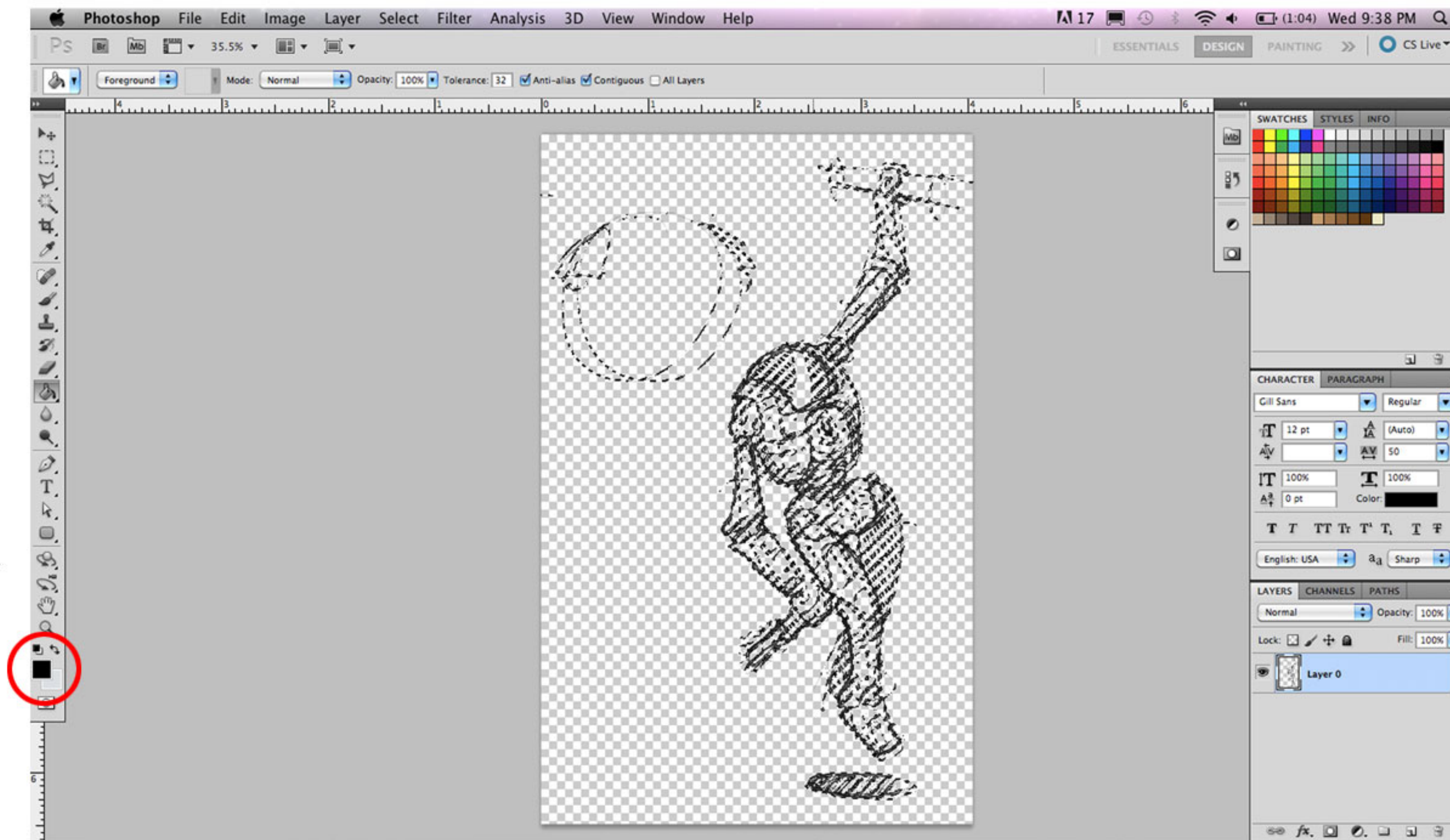
Step 11:

Select the paint bucket tool (G)



Step 12:

Select the color you want your linework to be. Then add the color to the layer



Step 13:

Clean up the sketch
as needed
