Assignment 6: Poster and Demo Session

Due: 8 April, 2014

This assignment is meant to mirror a poster and demo session at a major conference, such as CHI or Ubicomp where researchers share their latest progress on work that is still ongoing. You will be asked to prepare both a poster and a demo for this session to share with classmates, course staff, and invited guests.

Poster

Prepare an A0-sized poster describing your project. Your poster should include information about the motivation from your initial field study as well as some details about how the system works and the key use cases.

Prepare the poster so that it's easy to understand what problems your application solves at a glance and clearly provide subheadings so that viewers can focus on the areas that they are most interested in. Include a small section on future plans including plans for your field study.

Example posters can be found in the lecture notes.

Demo

Bring a working version of your application to the class in a form that can be demoed to visitors at your poster area. Note that this might require a quick way to reset part of the system depending on the use cases that you plan to demo. A demo should be short, 1-3 minutes and highlight the major use case of your system as well as show that the system is working as designed.
