

Instructions for using REDUCE within a dos emulator on Athena. The procedure will be similar if you use a dos emulator (dosemu, dosbox) on your own PC or even on your smartphone.

Open a terminal and create a folder called reduce by typing the following at the command prompt (\$):

```
$mkdir reduce
```

Now move the downloaded file supp1338.zip into the reduce folder:

```
$mv supp1338.zip reduce/
```

Now change into the reduce directory and unzip the zip file:

```
$cd reduce  
$unzip supp1338.zip
```

Now start dosemu:

```
$dosemu
```

The dosemu window will open up and some text will be displayed showing where your home directory was mounted for use with the emulator. In my case it was the D: drive. To switch to that drive type D: at the C:\> command prompt inside the dos box:

```
C:\> D:
```

Now your command prompt should look like:

```
D:\>
```

At this new command prompt type dir and you should see a listing of your Athena home directory contents including the reduce directory. Switch into the latter by typing:

```
D:\> cd reduce
```

Now, by typing "reduce.exe" at the D:\> command prompt the reduce program should open up and you are ready to use it.
