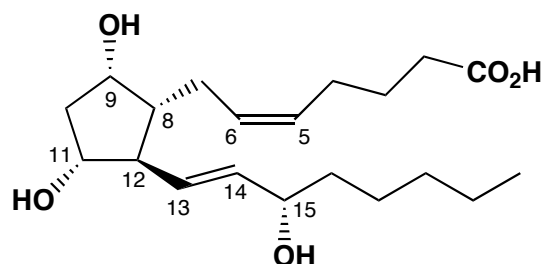

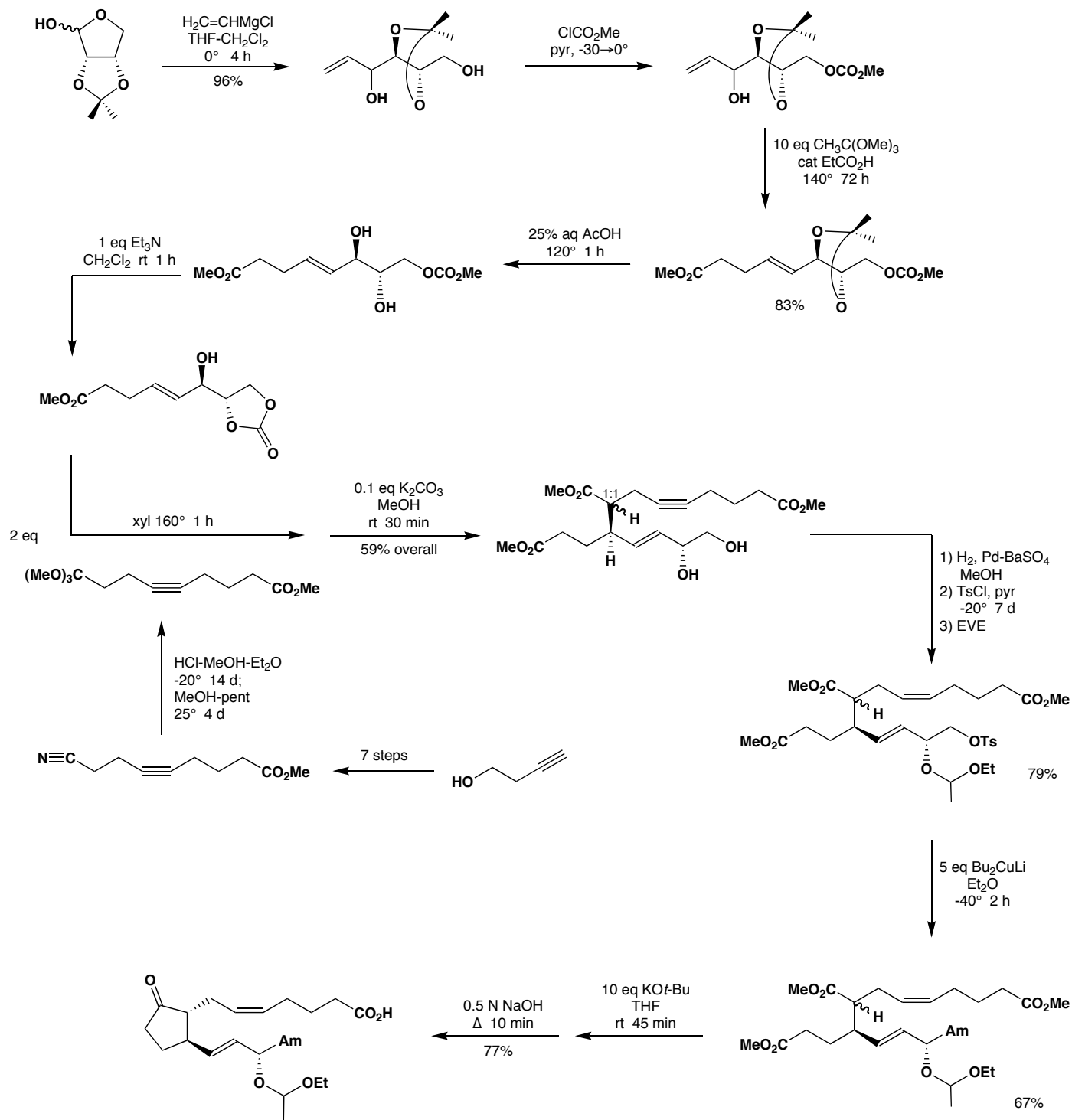

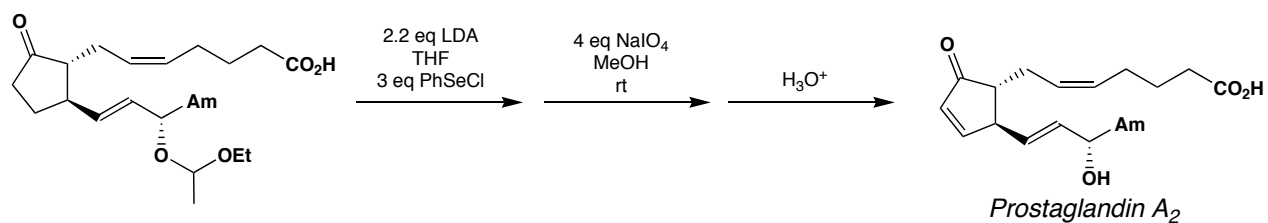

Stork Total Synthesis of Prostaglandins from Sugars

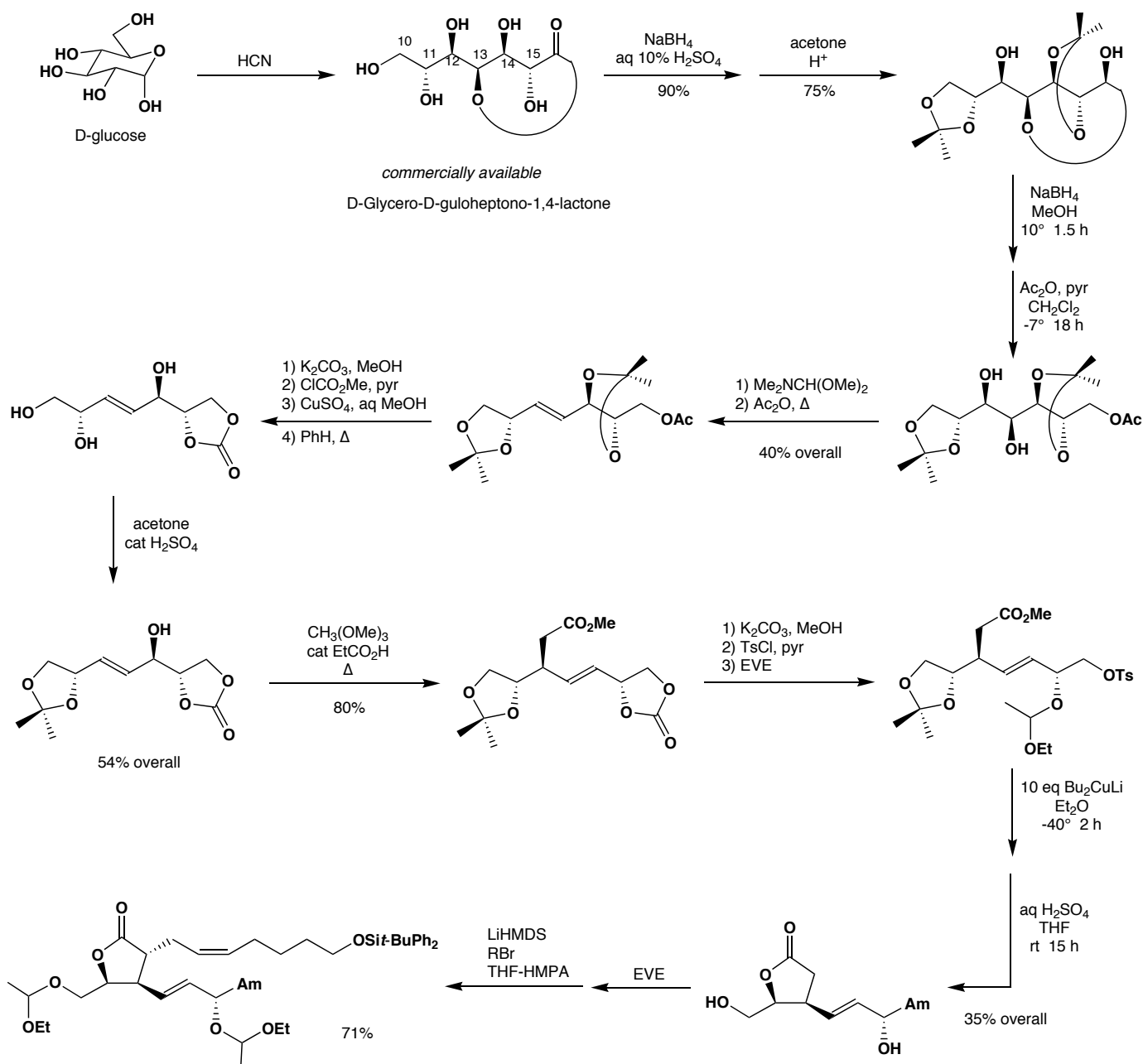
I. Total Synthesis of Prostaglandin A₂
