

GRADING

All the items below will enter in the computation of the final grade.

Quizzes: Two evening quizzes will take place on Wednesday, October 11, 2000 and Wednesday, November 15, 2000 from 7:30 PM to 9:30 PM in Walker Memorial. No homework is due on those weeks. To compensate for the evening exam, there will be no formal recitation sessions on those dates either. The instructors will be available in their offices to entertain your questions. Quizzes are open book and a calculator is required.

Final Exam: To be scheduled by the Registrar within the period of December 18-22. The final is a three-hour examination, open book and calculator required.

Homework: Problem Sets will be handed out on most Fridays (exception will be on weeks preceding the Quizzes when no homework will be handed out.) The homework is due at recitation the following Friday. This is a firm deadline. Homework turned in late will be graded but no credit given. All homework sets will weigh equally towards the final grade.

Design Problems: Two design problems will be handed out during the course. The first design problem will be assigned on October 18, 2000 and is due November 1, 2000. The second design problem will be assigned on November 21, 2000 and is due December 1, 2000. The same policy as late Homework will be applied to Design Problems turned in late.
