
Select the “No, I need to purchase access online now” option.

**\*Create a Login Name**

**\*Create a Password**

Create a password. It must be at least 8 characters with at least one letter and one number. [See acceptable characters.](#)

Your password cannot be the same as your login name.

**\*Re-type your Password**

When you have entered your login information, you will then be asked to enter your payment information. Once you have paid, you will receive an access code that will allow you to register (if you get stuck, see the separate set of instructions for students who already have an access code from a textbook purchase).

Once you have finished registering, return to <http://masteringphysics.com>. Log in with your newly created ID and password. You will come to this screen:
