

Lesson Plan 23 Title: "Let's show it to our friends"

Concept / Terminology / Topic to Teach: present, explain

Class Goal(s)/Objectives: When having constructed the final model, engineers present them to colleagues or customers. Today children will present their work to children from other classrooms, and they will create invitations to invite their parents to come and see their work.

Required Materials: 2 gender neutral puppets, colorful paper, printouts with the text to be placed in the invitation cards, water paint, glue, markers, and colorful images presenting buildings relevant to children's models, an image to be placed on the wall. It is suggested that the teacher will create a poster presenting photos of the children's work constructed throughout the curriculum.

Setting: Classroom, Large group time, small group time, extra time allocated for the other class's visit and the presentation.

Step-By-Step Procedures: During large group time you will start with revisiting what the final goal is by discussing what the children built in the last session. While having the children see their and the images on the wall, walk with them through the whole engineering process followed since the beginning of the project.

Plan For Independent Practice: Have the children create invitations for their parents. Give them all the materials available but allow children to personalize the cards with their own taste.

Closure (Reflect Anticipatory Set): End the class with the presentation to the class invited. During the presentation have the children stand up one at a time, and present to their friends what they did throughout the semester. Encourage the children to use the images on the wall as assistance to their presentation.

Assessment Based On Objectives: Every child should have created an invitation card. Furthermore every child should demonstrate the ability to look at the images and describe the activity presented.

Possible Connections To Other Subjects: language and reasoning (while presenting the previous activities), art (while creating the cards).
