### I. Class Materials

## 1. Download Graphics.tar

#### On Athena:

Copy the archive file from the locker **acmath** to a local working directory.

athena% add acmath athena% cp /mit/acmath/math/IntroMathematica/Graphics.tar .

Download the archive file from http://web.mit.edu/acmath/math/IntroMathematica.

### 2. Extract this session's directory and files

#### On Athena:

tar -xvf Graphics.tar

### II. Start Mathematica

#### On Athena:

Launch *Mathematica* from the **Graphics** directory:

athena% cd Graphics athena% add math athena% mathematica &
