Dear Fellow FSILG Alumni and Undergraduate Presidents:

On behalf of the AILG Accreditation Committee, I would like to wish all of you a Happy New Year, and where appropriate, a Merry Christmas or Happy Hannukah, and to the undergraduates, an enjoyable winter break.

This message announces our Spring 2009 Accreditation Schedule, but first a paragraph about the results from Fall 2008:

We have just completed a very busy Fall Accreditation schedule, performing reviews at sixteen FSILGs. The Visiting Committees recommended eleven of these for accreditation. Three FSILGs were recommended for accreditation with reservations, and two FSILGs will have their results announced in January after the AILG Board has reviewed the reports.

Our schedule for Spring 2009 will be even busier: we have eighteen FSILGs to review. We have fixed the dates for reviews to be the first Saturdays of each month: 7 Feb, 7 Mar, 4 Apr, and 2 May.

We need each FSILG to confirm the dates assigned below as soon as possible. Changes will be accommodated on a first-come, first-changed basis. Just as a reminder to the undergraduates: these reviews are officially conducted through your alumni organizations: if changes are needed, please have your alumni officers contact me.

The five organizations scheduled for February will need to start working on completing the Basic Data Form as soon as possible; it will be due on Sunday, 25 January. Please establish contact between alumni and undergraduates during IAP to make sure this is done. Please see the website above for access to the online data form.
