Dear Fellow FSILG Alumni and Undergraduate Presidents

As announced at the recent AILG Plenary meeting, our Spring 2011 Accreditation Schedule will include the following four Saturdays: 2/12, 3/5, 4/2, and 5/7.

- A. FSILGs scheduled are requested to reply to confirm dates.
- B. Visiting Committee volunteers are requested to reply with their availability.

The MIT AILG Accreditation Committee is inviting the following FSILGs to be reviewed during Spring 2011:

BTP, CP, DTD, DU, Fenway, KAT, LCA, ND, No6, PKT, pika, SAE, SK, TDC, WILG, and ZBT.

Please send me a request for a date no later than Monday, January 3rd. I will assign dates with preference given to those who respond the earliest, but will give organizations on a less-than-2year cycle priority for the April and May dates. Please also indicate whether you prefer a morning (9-11) or afternoon (1-3) time slot. We require a minimum of three alumni and three undergraduates to be present, and prefer a larger representation from both alumni and undergraduate leaders.

These reviews are officially conducted through the alumni organizations, and the official response should come from or be authorized by a representative of the alumni corporation.

I will have an updated version of the online Basic Data Form available by Saturday, 1 January. You may still wish to take a look at the Fall 2010 form, accessible via the Accreditation Coordinator's web page at <http://web.mit.edu/covert/ailgreviews/> in order to plan for the information you'll need to collect. As in the past, information collected with older versions of the form will be able to automatically pre-fill the new form.

I also would like to ask all alumni/ae who wish to serve on a visiting committee to please contact me immediately with your availability for each of the three dates, especially for 2/12. I hope to be able to schedule volunteers for no more than a single Saturday this Spring. I would also like to have new volunteers. Our Visiting Committee members are drawn from only half of our organizations. We have a goal of increasing our volunteer pool to include at least one visitor from each FSILG.
