

**MIT AILG Annual Meeting
Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, June 11, 2014, 8:10PM in the MIT Museum**

The meeting was called to order at 8:10pm.

Approximately 80 members of the AILG community attended, including alumni volunteers, students, MIT staff and administrators and Keynote Speaker Judy Cole. Prior to the start of the meeting, Judy spoke about how FSILG alumni are consistently more involved with and more philanthropic toward MIT than non-FSILG alumni, and she thanked the community for our participation.

Steve Baker welcomed everyone to the business portion of the Annual Meeting.

Dick Larson presented the Annual Report. He spoke about his conversations regarding the FSILG community with incoming MIT Chancellor Cynthia Barnhart, and he expressed the need for the community to come together to address the many common issues facing all of us including the external perception of FSILGs, the definition of hazing, and our opportunity to foster and promote student leadership.

Anya Kattaf presented the proposed 2014-2015 AILG budget and reviewed changes from the previous year's budget. The 2014-2015 budget was unanimously adopted by the membership.

AILG annual Directors elections were held. Prof. Richard Larson (Phi Beta Epsilon) and Alice Leung (Epsilon Theta) were each re-elected by unanimous consent to three year terms. Akil Middleton (Zeta Psi) was elected by unanimous consent to a one-year term replacing Board member Richard Possemato (Nu Delta), who resigned his position early.

Three individuals were elected Ombudspersons for a term of one year by unanimous consent: Stan Wulf (Phi Delta Theta), Tom Yu (Fenway House) and Kim Hunter (Alpha Phi).

Adam McCready and Marlina Martinez Love were each presented with a certificate and Rich Possemato was presented with an MIT tapestry and heartily thanked for their work with on behalf of the FSILGs and the AILG community.

The meeting adjourned at 9PM.
