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Accidental Death Risk per Flight on Various Types of Scheduled Passenger Jet Services, 1990-99 and 2000-04

Death Risk per Flight:

<u>Type of Service</u>	<u>1990-99</u>	<u>2000-04</u>
Advanced-World Domestic	<i>1 in 13 million</i>	<i>Zero</i>
First-World International	<i>1 in 6 million</i>	<i>1 in 7 million</i>
Between First-World and Developing World	<i>1 in 1 million</i>	<i>1 in 1.5 million</i>
Within Developing World	<i>1 in 500,000</i>	<i>1 in 2 million</i>

Overall Death Risk per Scheduled US Domestic Jet Flight By Cause, for 1990-99 and 2000-04

<i>1990-99</i>	<i>1 in 11 million</i>	<i>0</i>	<i>1 in 11 million</i>
<i>2000-04</i>	<i>0</i>	<i>1 in 9 million</i>	<i>1 in 9 million</i>
