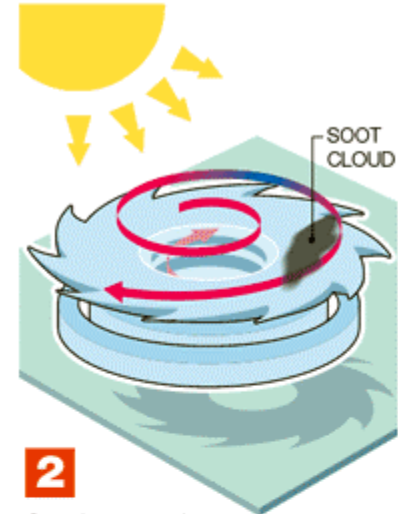
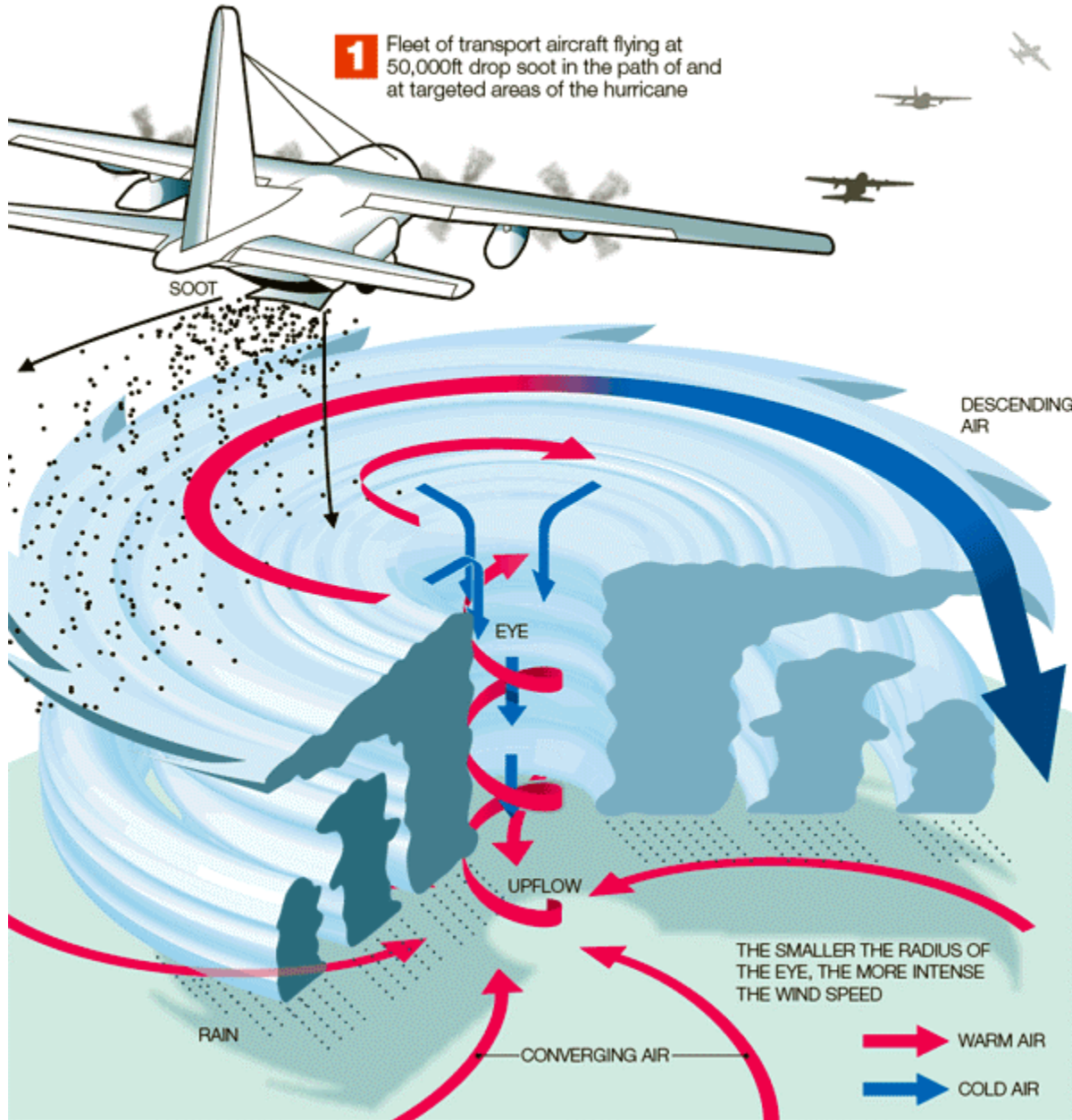
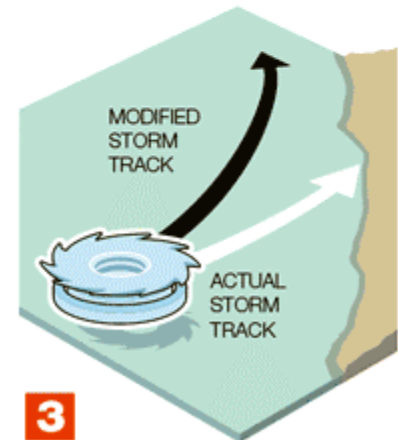


# HOW TO HALT A HURRICANE



Soot is warmed by the sun, heating the cool air around it at the very top of the hurricane. This reduces the flow of air within the hurricane and slows it down



Depending on where and when the soot is dropped the now weakened hurricane will change course
