Dear Postal Customer:

Changes in consumer preference and recession-related declines in mail volume have reduced U.S. Postal Service revenues. Operation of the Postal Service is paid for by postage and fees paid by our customers. The Postal Service receives no operational subsidy from taxes. Current economic conditions require that we review all postal operations for opportunities to streamline processes and provide service more efficiently.

As the Postmaster responsible for all offices in your area, I would like your opinion concerning a possible change in the way your postal service is provided. A review of the business activities of the MIT Post Office revealed that the office workload has declined. This reduced workload and the fact that we have another Post Office (Kendall Square Post Office) located 0.8 miles away from the MIT Post Office suggests that the continuation of the MIT Post office Unit may not be warranted.

Accordingly, we are considering discontinuance of the MIT Post Office, located at 84 Massachusetts Ave. in Cambridge, MA. If you are currently receiving letter carrier delivery, there will be no change to your delivery service. Any mail pickup of parcel and signature items would move to the Kendall Square Station, located at 250 Main Street in Cambridge, MA.

If you are a post office box customer, you have the option of post office box delivery at the Kendall Square Post Office or you may receive carrier delivery at your residence. Full retail service hours at the Kendall Square Post Office are from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The lobby at Kendall Square Station is open 24 hours a day.

The Postal Service operates to serve our customers. We value your opinions during this review process. Please complete the enclosed questionnaire and return with your comments by September 25, 2009 using the pre-addressed envelope provided.
