

# IM Bowling – Spring 2009 Announcement

## REGISTRATION

- Rosters should be e-mailed to manager Hongyou Xiong ([hongyou@mit.edu](mailto:hongyou@mit.edu)) by Saturday, February 28 at 11:59 PM. Teams should use the blank roster form available on the IM website. No late rosters will be accepted.
- All teams must pay a \$200 registration fee to participate. Fee should be delivered to Bernice Ward ([bward@mit.edu](mailto:bward@mit.edu)) in the Zesiger athletic offices prior to registration. Teams that have not paid fines or fees by 4:00PM on March 5, 2009 will be removed from the sport.
- Teams must designate a captain on their entry form. This person will be responsible for handling all correspondence for the team, including rescheduling of matches, resolving disputes, etc. Captains are responsible for reviewing the MIT IM handbook and ensuring that their affiliations and teams are in compliance with all regulations.

## ROSTERS

- Participation is limited to registered (or cross-registered) undergraduate and graduate students, post-docs, faculty, and alumni with DAPER or alumni association membership.
- Rosters should consist of 4 – 10 players.
- No player may be on more than one team.
- Roster challenges may be initiated by anyone before, during, or after a match. Any team found to be playing with an ineligible player or a player not on its roster will forfeit the match and face corresponding fines at the discretion of the manager. Teams wishing to file this type of complaint should immediately inform the opposing team captain, manager, and referee, if applicable.

## LEAGUES

- When registering, teams should indicate their preference of league (level of competition). Leagues may be combined or split at manager's discretion.
  - A – 70% handicap
  - B – 90% handicap

## FINES

- No fines for forfeiting will be charged due to the \$200 entry fee.

## SCHEDULE

- The 2009 bowling season will begin mid-March and end early May for a total of 8 weeks. The matches will be held on Saturday afternoons at Boston Bowl located in South Boston, which is accessible by a 10-20 minute drive, or by taking the T Red Line to JFK UMass and taking the courtesy shuttle, which runs every 30 minutes.

## **RULES / MISCELLANEOUS**

- Players must be present at a match within 10 minutes of game time. A team that has less than 3 players forfeits the match.
