# Advancing the FSILG Agenda

- Information Services & Technology
  - Fiber optic connection to all off-campus houses
  - Established “net contacts” support group
- Department of Facilities
  - Survey of all FSILG houses to qualify for IRDF grants
  - Extending campus map on web to include all FSILGs
  - Organized the House Manager 101 course
- Treasurer’s Office
  - Administers IRDF program, including new Annual Operating Grants
  - Teach the two day course “Treasurer 101”

# Advancing the FSILG Agenda

- Academic Resource Center & Admissions
  - Moved up Rush period to immediately following Orientation
  - Provides many opportunities for FSILG involvement in Campus Preview Weekend, Orientation, Summer send-offs, etc.
  - Distributed Living Options guide to 2,500 Educational Councilors
- Dean's Offices and Medical
  - Developed Alumni Risk Management Advisor program
  - Hired Health & Wellness aide to focus on FSILGs
- Chancellor's and Provost's Offices
  - Provided Funding for Recruitment & retention Initiative (RRI)
  - Reviewing leases for 8 chapters renting MIT buildings and/or land
  - With AILG, funding half of new Building Safety Facilitator
  - Established Aurora Advisory Group of senior alumni/ae

# Advancing the FSILG Agenda

- MIT Alumni Association
  - Created “FSILG toolkit”, for use by chapter Alumni Corporations – communications, volunteer, event planning and financial items
  - Direct support for Reunion and campus events
  - Host the AILG Board Meetings
  - Initiated regular electronic communications to all FSILG alums
  - Sponsored outreach effort to MIT Clubs across the United States
