This *Microforms Holdings List* is a complete catalog of all the microform (i.e. microfilm, microfiche and microcard) materials located in the Microforms area on Level One of O'Neill Library.

The journals, periodicals and special sets in this list are arranged in alphabetical order, word-by-word, by the title of the periodical or set. Abbreviations and acronyms are filed at the beginning of a letter. For example:

ALA Bulletin comes before *Advertising Age*

FDA Consumer comes before *Federal Reserve Bulletin*

New York Times comes before *Newsweek*

Below each title you will find the holdings information that tells you what range of years are available and the format of the item (film, fiche or card). Some sample entries are listed below:

A closed date (**IRISH PRESS** example) means that our holdings end with the last date listed. A date with a plus sign (+) (**NEW YORK TIMES** example) means that we are still receiving that title.

Microfilm and microfiche are kept in room 104. Microfilm are filed alphabetically by title. Microfiche are filed alphabetically in two series: Periodical Fiche followed by Special Sets.

The government documents fiche collection is kept in the public area, and is organized by SuDoc number.

The microcard collection is kept in the reader-printer room, and in the compact shelving. It is also organized alphabetically.
