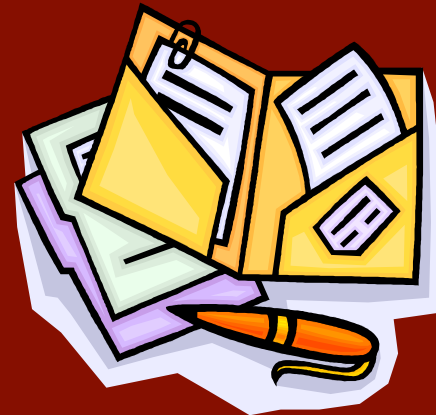
# 2007-08 checklist:

- ✓ Resolve any pending student account balance
- ✓ If necessary, sign any loan promissory notes and complete entrance interviews

# 2008-09 checklist:

✓ Complete your application in for aid:

- FAFSA
- Profile
- IDOC



- Set up a meeting with your Student Account Counselor to arrange processes for sending you money

# Changes to your Aid Budget:

- Fees, books, personal and travel expense components of your budget will be increased over the standard budgeted costs to take into consideration the costs associated with the program.

# Once awarded:

- ✓ Complete your self-help form
- ✓ Determine how to plan to meet your Summer Earnings Expectation
- ✓ Make sure your address is updated on WEBSIS.

# Once you arrive:

- ✓ Sign your loan notes (request that they be mailed to you by sending an email to [gnovack@mit.edu](mailto:gnovack@mit.edu))
- ✓ Request any financial aid proceeds above the cost of tuition be sent to you directly (or through your parents) to pay room, board, other expenses
  - *We won't post your proceeds until Cambridge University verifies your enrollment*
- ✓ In January 2009, make sure you begin the application process for financial aid for the 2009-2010 year (deadline is 4/15/09)
