Academic Performance, Committee on

The Committee on Academic Performance is concerned with the academic performance of undergraduates. It makes recommendations to the faculty on such matters as minimum scholastic standards, calendar changes, examinations, and grading, in consultation with the Committee on Graduate Programs on those matters which also relate to graduate students. The Committee acts with power on petitions from individual undergraduate students relating to exceptions to established academic standards, and on applications for readmission at the undergraduate level. At the conclusion of each regular examination period, the Committee shall hold meetings with representatives of the Office of the Dean for Undergraduate Education and of the second-year, third-year, and fourth-year Faculty Advisors, in order to review the academic records of undergraduate students and to take appropriate action in the name of the Faculty. The Committee presents to the Faculty its recommendations on candidates to be awarded Bachelor's degrees, and also a summary of its other actions.

From *Rules and Regulations*:

The Committee on Academic Performance shall consist of six elected members of the Faculty, three undergraduate students, and the following *ex officio* nonvoting members or their designates: the Dean for Undergraduate Education; the Registrar; the Medical Director; the Executive Director, Student Financial Services; the Heads of Student Support Services; Disability Support Services; and one additional member designated by the Dean for Undergraduate Education.
