The Committee on Curricula serves to implement the General Institute Requirements and Course Curricula for undergraduates, including acting with power on: a) proposals for changes in the Institute requirements and making recommendations to the Faculty; b) proposals for Science Distribution and Laboratory subjects; c) requests from individual students for exceptions to the General Institute Requirements; d) proposals for changes in undergraduate subjects of instruction; e) proposals for new curricula, changes in existing curricula, and the discontinuation of existing curricula; in addition to, f) reviewing departmental reports on individual student's programs that include major departures from an approved curriculum.

From *Rules and Regulations*:

The Committee on Curricula shall consist of six elected Faculty members, four undergraduate student members, and the following *ex officio*s, nonvoting members: the Dean for Undergraduate Education, the Registrar, and one member designated by the Dean for Undergraduate Education, and the Chair of the Committee on the Undergraduate Program.
