The Committee on the Undergraduate Program oversees undergraduate education, including the freshman year, undergraduate advising, the General Institute Requirements, and interdepartmental programs, giving attention to both short- and long-term trends and directions. This committee is responsible for encouraging experimental innovation in undergraduate educational policy. The committee exercises authority to approve and supervise limited educational experiments.

From *Rules and Regulations*:

The Committee on the Undergraduate Program shall consist of seven elected faculty members, the Associate Chair of the Faculty, four undergraduate student members, and ex officio, the Chancellor (or designate), the Dean for Undergraduate Education, and one member designated by the Dean for Undergraduate Education. The Chair of the Faculty shall appoint the Chair of the Committee from the group consisting of the seven elected members and the Associate Chair of the Faculty.
