

## Current Committee Membership

### Discipline, Committee on

The Committee on Discipline (COD) shall consider such cases of alleged misconduct by students as shall be brought to its attention by the Dean of Students and Undergraduate Education or by any member of the MIT community. An accused student shall be given an opportunity to appear in person at a COD meeting. If the findings of the committee include a recommendation that a student be required to withdraw from the Institute, the recommendation with the findings shall be reported to the President for approval or disapproval; otherwise, the COD shall act with power.

From *Rules and Regulations*:

The Committee on Discipline shall consist of the Dean for Undergraduate Education and the Dean for Student Life, ex officii; six elected members of the Faculty; and three undergraduate and two graduate students. Past members who have completed their terms may, for a period of three years thereafter, be called to fill out a quorum for a particular hearing, only one such member to serve in a given hearing.
