### Topics Discussed:

#### 1. Organizational business

- Please e-mail out to your dorms about the DormCon elections for VP for REX, REX chairs, and Treasurer that we will be having next meeting. I'll send out another e-mail for you guys to e-mail
- There are some e-mail lists embedded in the dorms-prez list that I don't have access to you, so please make sure your dorm(x)-president lists are up to date.
- At the suggestion of Alex Penn, we will start having DormCon meetings in different dorms again.
- DormCon minutes will now be held at **5:30** p.m. instead of 5:00 p.m. because there are more people who will be able to make it.

#### 2. Diandra - REX/CPW business

- Are everyone's REX chairs the same as their CPW chairs? *Response: About half yes, half no*
- I'm going to pass around a sheet of paper, and I would appreciate if everyone could fill it out with the names of their REX chairs.

- I met with someone about CPW recently, and I was told that the new VP for REX will probably be working closely with admissions during CPW. Also, there will be mandatory training sessions for CPW chairs, and those training sessions will discuss things like how to reserve space and register events. This training is required for all CPW chairs, and at least one person from each dorm must attend to be able to register CPW events for your dorm.

### 3. REX

- Summary of DormCon's meetings with the administrators
  - Some DormCon members met with Dean Norman and Dean Young, and then separately with Dean Hastings.
  - In the meeting, Dean Hastings agreed that REX will not be shortened from its length last year.
  - Also, the date that non FPOP freshmen can arrive has been moved up to Saturday.
  - Dean Hastings seemed flexible about moving the time of the end of the housing readjustment lottery.
  - The most important thing for us as DormCon to do right now is to define exactly what is meant by the length of REX.
- How to define REX?
  - Starting from the time that the last student arrives on campus and going until the closing of the readjustment lottery?
  - Starting from the earliest that all students can arrive on campus and going until the closing of the readjustment lottery? Problem with that is that the students in FPOPs won't be able to participate in the first few days of REX by that definition.
  - Maybe we should consider possible student participation hours as the time that students can spend on REX
  - We should think about making REX more days, and having REX officially be at night (ex. 5 p.m. on) and Orientation be during the days.
- We should come up with a proposed solution to take to Dean Norman next week (a committee was created to formulate a proposal by Saturday at midnight)
- Question about RBA: Do we know how Next House and Masseh Hall will work in terms of RBA?
- Answer: Next House will have non-binding RBA, but we don't know about Masseh yet.
