

Cat Registration Transfer Form

This form should be submitted to the dorm Pet Chair in order to transfer the registration of a cat to a new owner.

If the transferee does not live in the same cat-friendly area as the transferor, he/she must first complete a copy of the Cat Approval Form and get it approved by the Housing office before the cat registration can be transferred.

A completed copy of the roommate consent form signed by the transferee's roommates and/or suite-mates must be attached to this form.

The owner must attach to this form a picture of the cat and a written statement from a licensed veterinarian certifying that:

- The cat is up to date on FIV, FeLV, rabies, and distemper vaccinations, and
- the cat is spayed or neutered, or
- the cat is too young to be spayed or neutered.

If the cat is too young to be spayed or neutered, the veterinarian should specify a date by which the cat should be spayed or neutered.

These documents and the photo may be acquired from the Pet Chair of the transferor's dormitory.
