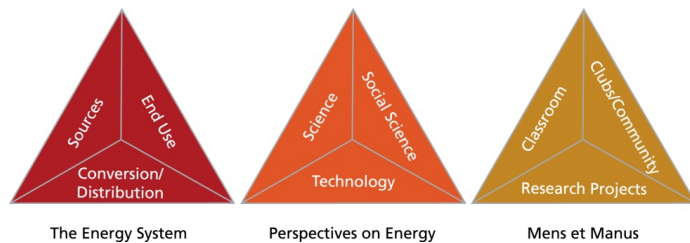


Energy Education CALL FOR PROPOSALS



The Energy Education Task Force (EETF) welcomes proposals for new or substantially revised energy-focused subjects.

Priority areas for undergraduate energy curriculum development include:

- **Early engagement experiences** such as freshman advising seminars, IAP experiences, 9-unit spring subjects targeted for first- and second-year students.
- **Project/design/laboratory-based subjects.**
- **Subjects focused on the social science of energy**, including subjects that integrate more than one perspective.
- **Subjects focused on energy technology/engineering**, which may examine a single technology from development to deployment, compare several technologies, or focus on energy end-use.

Funding levels depend on the level of development required and **may range from < \$10,000 to > \$100,000.**

Committee Approval Processes and Requirements:

- Proposed subjects should be intended as permanent additions to the MIT undergraduate curriculum.
- The Committee on Curricula (CoC) and any other relevant Institute committees (for example, the Subcommittee on the Communication Requirement (SOCR) and/or the Subcommittee on the HASS Requirement (SHR)) will review proposals. Please note that approval and funding of a subject by the EETF and/or Energy Minor Oversight Committee **do not** constitute CoC, SOCR, or SHR approval.
- All proposals are subject to the review, approval, and budgeting cycles of all relevant Institute committees.

Proposals are accepted on a rolling basis and reviewed monthly by the EETF and the Energy Minor Oversight Committee. Proposals may include costs for development and first year delivery, as well as modest support for delivery in years 2 and 3. Proposals leveraging other forms of support are particularly welcome.
