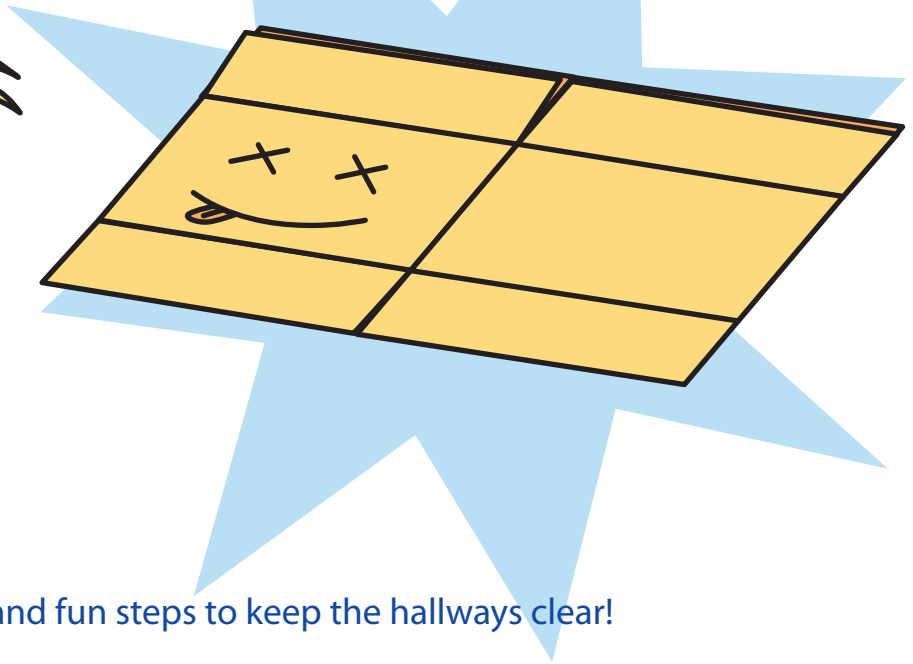
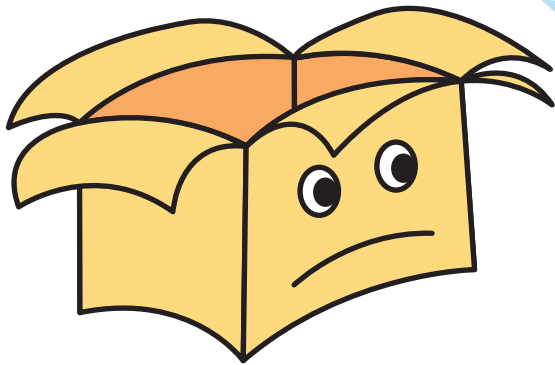


Break Down Your Boxes!



Follow these easy-to-remember and fun steps to keep the hallways clear!

1. Remove all polystyrene packing materials.
2. Flatten cardboard.
3. Place next to or inside mixed paper recycling bins.

Note: When placing boxes next to recycling bins, please be sure not to impede traffic, create a tripping hazard, or create a fire hazard. For oversized items, request a special pickup from recycling@mit.edu.

What cardboard can be recycled?

Do Recycle

- » Corrugated cardboard
- » Un-corrugated cardboard
- » Large chipboard boxes

Do Not Recycle

- » Packing materials*
- » Boxes that are covered in tape
- » Wax-coated boxes
- » Boxes that have been soaked by food waste

*Packing Peanuts (clean and usable) can be donated to Mail Services to be packed again. Sealed bags of peanuts should be placed next to an interdepartmental mailbox and addressed to: Packing Peanuts Reuse Program, WW15.
