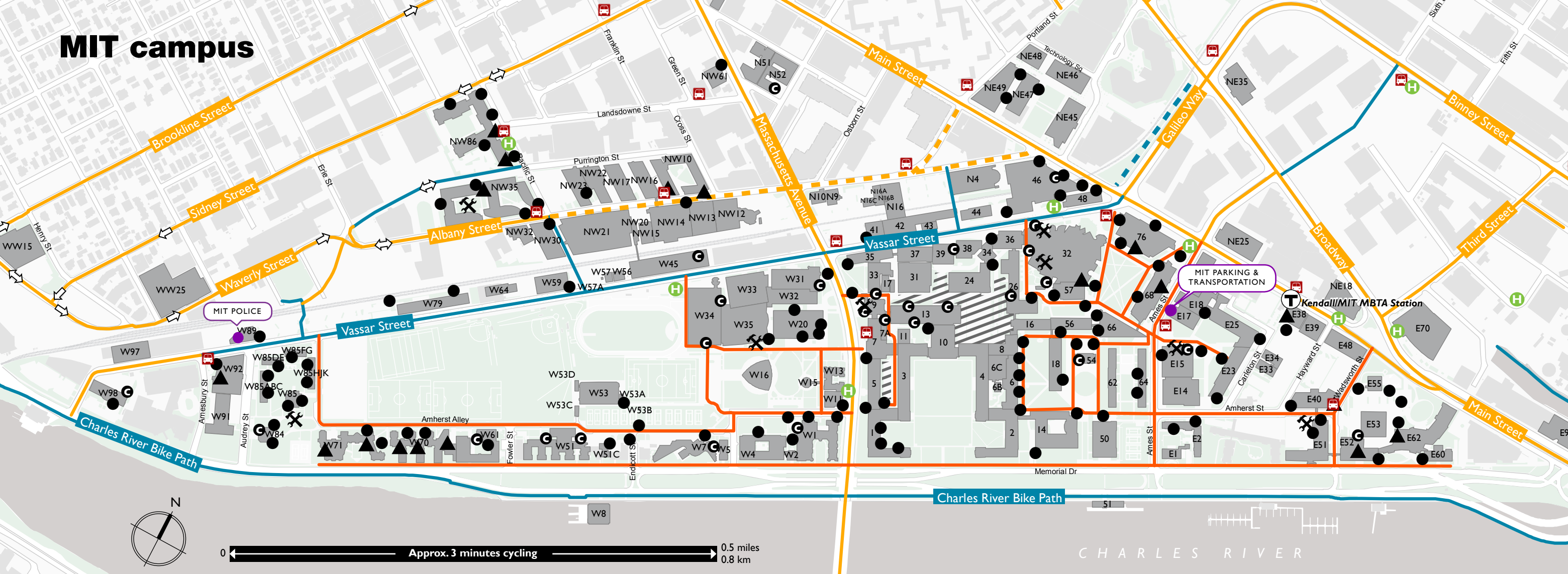
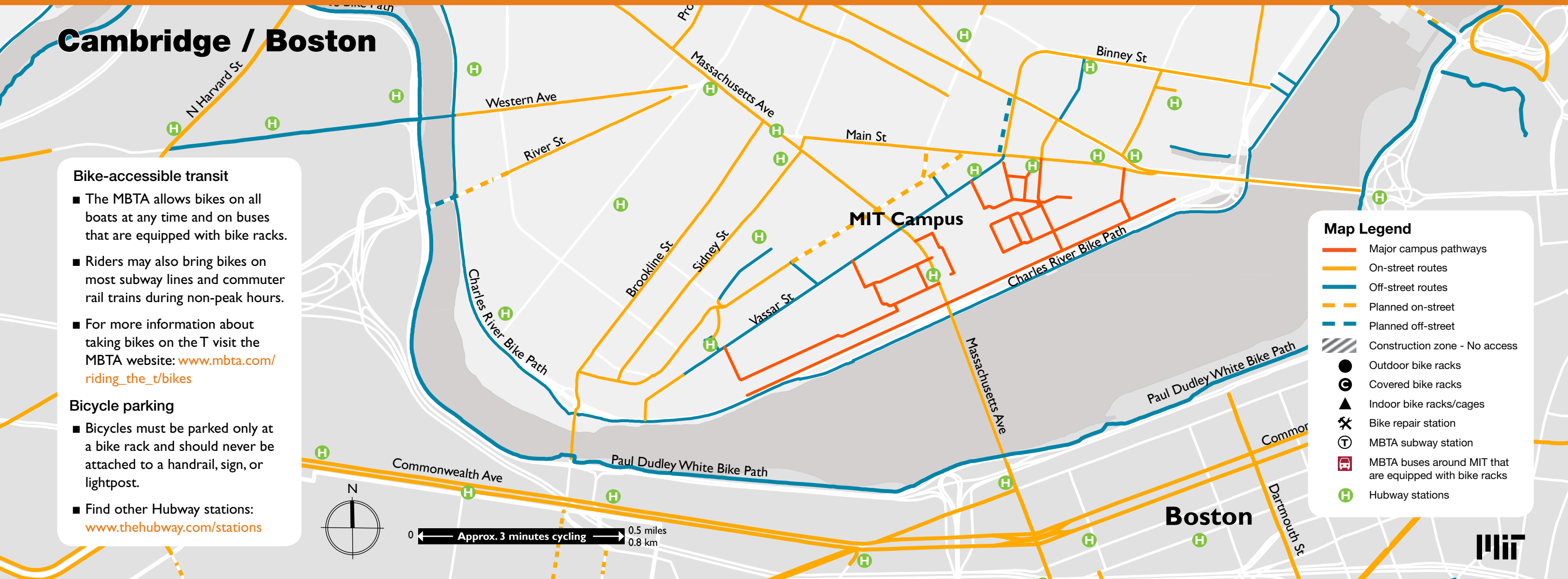

### Bike-accessible transit

- The MBTA allows bikes on all boats at any time and on buses that are equipped with bike racks.
- Riders may also bring bikes on most subway lines and commuter rail trains during non-peak hours.
