

VEHICLE PARKING AND ACCESS REQUIREMENTS TO MIT LINCOLN LABORATORY PROPERTY

- All vehicles must register with the MIT/LL Security Services Department
- Vehicle registration and proof of insurance required for vehicle decal
- All drivers must have a valid license
- All motorists and passengers are required to wear a safety belt
- All vehicles are subject to random vehicle searches by U.S. Air Force personnel
- The use of any portable headphones, earphones, or other listening devices while operating a motor vehicle is prohibited at all times unless using “hands-free” technology and then only if it does not interfere with the safe operation of the vehicle
- Operators must observe posted speed limit signs
- All vehicles must enter MIT Lincoln Laboratory property via the Wood Street gate (Gate 3)
- Operators will park only in areas designated by MIT Lincoln laboratory Security Services Department
- No weapons or illegal drugs are allowed on MIT Lincoln Laboratory property
- MIT Lincoln Laboratory is situated on Hanscom Air Force Base and is subject to Force Protection changes which may occur at any time. You may experience delays when entering or exiting the base during these times
