

Notes on the 5th String

Ex. 13

Open string 2nd fret 3rd fret

A B C

The first staff shows the notes A (open string), B (2nd fret), and C (3rd fret) on the 5th string. The second staff shows a descending scale from C back to the open string A.

Ex. 14 - C Major Scale
