 - One Representative for every 100 students (or fraction thereof) in each graduate department and program;
 - One Representative from each of the graduate residences;
 - Two Representatives living off-campus;
 - Five at-large Representatives (see <http://gsc.mit.edu> for details and current designations).
- Institute and non-Institute Committee Representatives (see <http://gsc.mit.edu> for details).

The GSC Bylaws provide for a nomination procedure whereby an individual must submit a nomination petition in order to be considered a voting member of the GSC. In the absence of opposition, submission of the petition is sufficient to join the Council. Should there be more than one candidate for an available position, the student organization of the said department or living group will, in conjunction with the Secretary of the GSC, conduct an election with the winner being the new representative from the group. The term of office extends one year beginning October 15. Applications are accepted year-round. Current representatives may seek re-election.
