

Thank you for your interest in MIT Tours! We look forward to welcoming your group to our campus in Cambridge, MA. Tours last between 75-90 minutes and are led by current MIT students, so that visitors can get a real sense of what it's like to be part of the MIT community. Tours include many highlights of campus life including the Stratton Student Center, Zesiger Athletic Center, Kresge Auditorium, the Infinite Corridor, the Green Building, Killian Court and the Great Dome, Barker Engineering Library, and the Frank Gehry-designed Stata Building, plus much more.

Groups larger than 10 are required to make a reservation at least 2 weeks in advance. The fee schedule is as follows:

Please note that MIT seeks out and admits the most talented and promising students without regard to their family financial circumstances. As such, this tour fee is waived for U.S. school groups who are sponsored by a middle or high school and reserved at least two weeks in advance by a teacher or counselor.

If your group has fewer than 10 visitors, you are welcome to join our free campus tour with no reservations necessary. There are tours at 11AM and 3PM Monday to Friday.

We send out final confirmation of tours 1-2 weeks before your tour. **Payment must be received before we can confirm your tour.** We are only able to accept credit cards, and will send your group an invoice including a link to a secure website for you to enter your details. To protect your privacy, we are unable to accept credit card details by phone, fax or e-mail.

Please note that submitting a request does not mean that you are confirmed for a tour. When we confirm, we will let you know the name of your guide(s), the exact time of your tour, starting location, and any other arrangements that may have been made.

Cancellations must be received no later than two business days before your requested tour date. Upon receipt of your cancellation, a refund will be issued less a 10% handling fee. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received within two business days of your requested tour date.

We train our student tour guides so they can provide you with an excellent visit. Please ensure your participants show the same respect to the Institute and all members of the MIT community. Failure to maintain appropriate behavior may result in the termination of your visit and loss of tour privileges in the future.

We will endeavor to accommodate your request for a tour day and time; however, due to campus events and staffing limitations, we may need to consider alternate dates. We strongly encourage submitting your request more than two weeks in advance, to improve the chances that your tour will be confirmed.
