Safety and Emergency Awareness

- Go over safety procedures: make sure to point out evacuation signs in your residence and let your prefrosh know how to leave the building in the event of an emergency
- Have your prefrosh program her cell phone (if she has one) with the MIT Police number: 671-253-1212
- Encourage your prefrosh to check in at the front desk of your residence hall each night
- If your prefrosh gets locked out after hours, have him call Night Watch at 671-253-1500
- Make sure your prefrosh doesn't accidently go into restricted spaces or into a lab without permission; many labs contain hazardous materials
- Sign up for MIT Alert! <u>emergency.mit.edu/mitalert</u>
- Give your prefrosh your full name, residence, room number, and phone number in case she need to reach you
- Point out Blue Light Phones that are all over campus
