PARENT-STUDENT CONTRACT OF COMMITMENT

AGREEMENT:

You are entering into an agreement with the Massachusetts Academic Games League of America.

COMMITMENT:

Through her eight years of experience learning, playing, and teaching Academic Games at the local, state, and national level, Bao Tran has found the Massachusetts Academic Games League and devised a plan to teach students the games and prepare them to compete at the national level. This approach requires students to be committed in participation, for if they do not take this program seriously, a lot of hard work and volunteered hours from numerous individuals including Tran will be wasted.

A student's full commitment to the program is required. This commitment requires the following from the student:

- Attending the three practices every week
- Being respectful of all adults, coaches, volunteers, and students involved in MAGLOA. Good conduct will always be required!
- Learning, studying, and playing all five games: Equations, On-Sets, Propaganda, Presidents, and LinguiSHTIK
- Attending the national tournament (if qualified) in April 2008

FEES:

Because of operational expenses and to establish commitment, a participation/membership fee of \$30.00 is required. The money is nonrefundable. It will be used to buy the games and provide all students with rules and guidelines.

WITHDRAWAL/DISMISSAL:

At any time in which a student decide to withdraw from the program or the Board of Director(s)/Coach(es) vote that a student does not display full commitment as outlined in the contract, the \$30.00 fee will not be refunded and the students will be expelled from MAGLOA and will not be allowed to participate in Academic Games with the league at any time.
