General information on the MIT Pistol & Rifle Club, Inc. (MITPRC)

Membership:

From the Club's Bylaws: "Any present or past member of the faculty or staff, or employee or student of M.I.T. or former Member of MITPRC or any other person eligible to use the facilities of the M.I.T. Department of Athletics, Physical Education and Recreation (DAPER), having met the membership requirements set by the Executive Committee, may become a Member of MITPRC. These requirements shall include having a Massachusetts License to Carry Firearms or Firearms Identification Card or proof of having successfully completed a National Rifle Association or Club-approved firearms safety course."

At the request of the MIT Police Department, for security reasons, the Executive Committee has restricted membership to those persons who have a current or former MIT Affiliation. This includes, in addition to MIT Students, Staff and Alumni, employees of Draper Lahs, Lincoln Lah, Whitehead, etc. Also members of affiliated schools: Harvard and Wellesley. However, see note under MIT Campus Firearms Permit.

MIT Firearms Permit:

Massachusetts Law – MGL Chapter 269(10)(j) – prohibits firearms (including air guns) on school and college campuses without written authorization of the school administration. The MIT Firearms Permit is that written authorization. MITPRC Members wishing to carry guns (including Air Guns) on and off campus must have an MIT Firearms Permit issued by the MIT Police. This permit is currently available to MITPRC Members holding an LTC or FID with current MIT Affiliation, including retired employees. At this time, the permit is NOT available to former (non-retiree) employees (with certain "grandfathered" exceptions) or Harvard and Wellesley affiliated members. We hope to change this in the future, but these are the current rules under which we must operate. Note that neither your MITPRC Membership card nor a DAPER membership card nor an MIT ID Card is an MIT Firearms Permit. **MIT Police contact: Capt. David Carlson - 617-253-9751**

Range Access:

If you wish to use the MIT Range, you will need athletic facility access in addition to MITPRC membership. MIT Students have free access to the athletic facilities. Other MIT and affiliated persons may purchase a regular DAPER membership that allows the use of DAPER's extensive sports, physical education and recreation facilities. This card is a bargain compared to other fitness clubs, etc. See the DAPER web site: http://mitrecsports.com/membership-pass-types/default.aspx for more info. If you only want to use the MIT Shooting Facility, MITPRC has arranged a special MITPRC Access with DAPER, which costs \$75 per year. MITPRC Activities:

Most of the Club's activities at the MIT Range revolve around the Pistol Range, although rifle shooting is available. Check with the Club Executive Committee about Rifle Range access, which may be possible.

Practice: The Club has the use of the Range on Tuesday Evenings from 6:30 PM until closing (typically we quit by 8:30 PM, but see note under GBPL) and on Sundays (typically 3:30 PM until 5:00 PM). Practice on Tuesdays when there is no GBPL home match and on Sundays is subject to interest and the availability of a Range Officer and is coordinated via email. For safety reasons, two persons must be present if firing is conducted. Rifles may be fired offhand in the Pistol Range. All shooting is limited to .22LR caliber.

GBPL: The Club fields a team in the Greater Boston Pistol League season running from October through April. All Club members are welcome; you don't have to be a world-class pistol shooter; the idea is to shoot and have fun. GBPL Matches are held on Tuesday evenings. Home matches at MIT begin between 7:30 and 8:00 PM, so practice stops shortly before the match begins. Away matches, due to the timing, only allow a very short (1/2 hour typical) practice session at MIT before leaving for the match. Unfortunately, since most active shooters and Range Officers shoot in GBPL, this cuts away-match Tuesday Practice sessions short.

EMRL: The Club typically fields two 6-person teams in the Eastern Massachusetts Rifle League, a three-match 200 yard outdoor offhand rifle league held on three Saturdays in April/May. The Club has some rifles and ammo available, and practice sessions are held.

Basic Pistol Marksmanship Courses: The Club generally tries to hold 2 to 4 courses every year. These courses meet the Massachusetts Firearms Licensing requirements. They are generally held on two consecutive Sundays, from about 10 AM to 5 PM. There is always a need for instructors and assistants to help conduct the courses safely. One does not need special training to assist in the courses. The proceeds from the courses go to support the shooting sports at MIT, in particular the MIT Sport Pistol Club (Former Varsity Pistol Team).

Misc. Club Projects: the Club occasionally performs work in the Range, such as cleaning the lead out of the bullet traps, rebuilding the backstop, etc.
