**Cambridge, MA** --John Durant, MIT Museum Director, recently announced the appointment of Seth Riskin to the post of Emerging Technologies Coordinator at the MIT Museum. In this position Mr. Riskin will be responsible for developing the exhibits in the Museum's Emerging Technologies Gallery, and will offer expertise to the MIT Museum's holography collection.

Riskin is an artist, researcher and teacher who studied fine art at Ohio State University, and has a master of science degree from MIT's Center for Advanced Visual Studies (CAVS). He has spent almost 20 years working at MIT on various projects involving collaborations between scientists, artists and engineers, many associated with CAVS, such as the Light, Space, Time; CAVS 25 Years exhibition at the MIT Museum.
