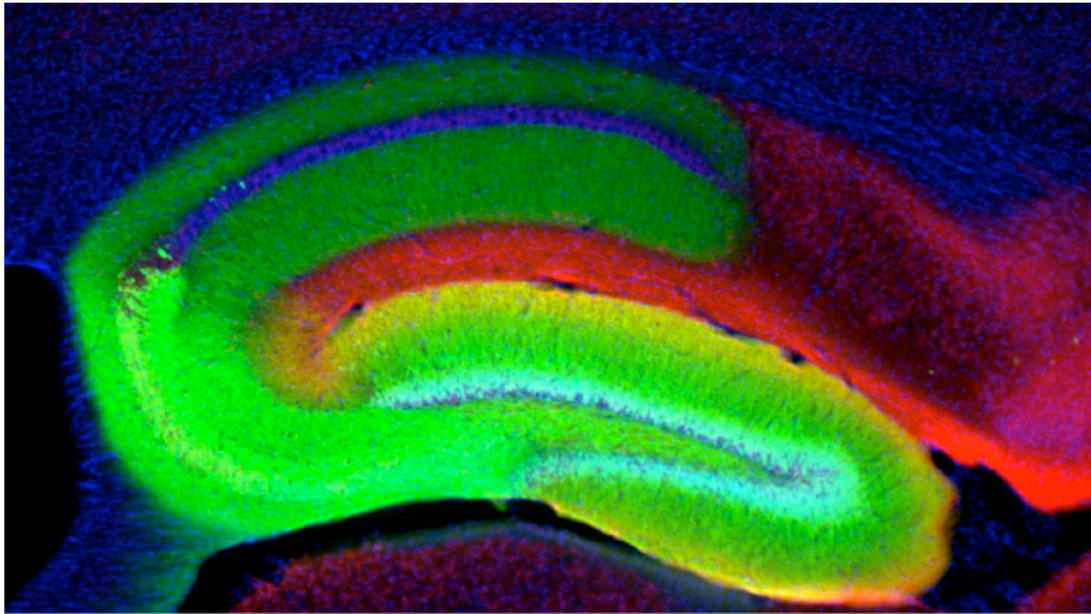


# *The Molecular & Cellular Neuroscience (MCN) Program's Breakfast With a Neuroscientist Series*
