Mr. DiVincenzo joined MIT as Litigation and Risk Management Counsel in the former Senior Counsel's Office in 2001. He was named Deputy General Counsel in early 2007. As MIT's Deputy General Counsel, Mr. DiVincenzo assists the Vice President and General Counsel in the overall management of the Office of the General Counsel and legal services at the Institute. Specifically, he has primary responsibility for management of Institute legal process and litigation; serves as the Institute's primary employment counsel, providing training, counseling and legal advice to departments, labs and centers and central human resources; and advises the Institute on a wide variety of issues including institute affairs, risk management, compliance and student life.

Prior to joining MIT, Mr. DiVincenzo practiced law with Burns and Levinson and with the Boston office of Jackson Lewis, a national labor and employment law firm. Mr. DiVincenzo has extensive experience in counseling employers in all types of labor and employment issues, including internal investigations and grievances, reorganizations, disability and discrimination issues, and in training employers on variety of employment related matters. He also has substantial experience in risk management counseling, complex litigation, trial practice, arbitrations, mediations, and negotiations.

Mr. DiVincenzo is an active member of the National Association of College and University Attorneys, and the Boston Bar Association's College and University Section Steering Committee. He speaks frequently on employment, risk management and other legal issues affecting higher education.

Mr. DiVincenzo graduated from Boston College in 1985 with a B.A., *magna cum laude*, and received his J.D. from the Cornell Law School in 1988.
