## BLAZING TRAILS

Walkabouts seldom proceed in a straight line. After beginning in the direction indicated from each starting point, most entries will make exactly one $90^{\circ}$ turn somewhere along their length, with the remainder making exactly two such turns. Each square is used by exactly two entries. Don't worry about getting lost, as the double-turning trails are clearly marked with dabs of paint.
