- (2) a. No QR:
[[some [book [which₂ [every student] read t₂]]] is on sale]
- b. QR of *[every student]* out of the relative clause:
[every student]₁ [[some [book [which₂ t₁ read t₂]]] is on sale]

Compute the truth conditions of (2a, b). Which of the two representations corresponds to the actual truth conditions of (1)?
