**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR A DOUBLE MAJOR**

- **You must be a registered undergraduate** who has completed at least three terms at MIT, including at least one term in a department with a declared major. If you are a transfer student, you must complete at least two terms of work at MIT, at least one of which must be in a department with a declared major.
- **You must submit your application on or before the Add Date of your penultimate term.**
- **You must have a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher.** Although not encouraged, students with a lower GPA may apply. The CoC will consider these applications on a case-by-case basis at its discretion; additional documentation may be required. Note: The Committee will consider late applications at its discretion only under extenuating circumstances.
