

Some Commands for Using Zephyr

Here are a few useful commands to toggle your settings for the RSI mailing lists (groups? classes?) within Zephyr, and how to write to each of them. You should type these commands inside your terminal.

- `zrsion`: This will add you to the `rsi-talk` list.
- `zrsioff`: This will remove you from the `rsi-talk` list.
- `zrsihelpon`: This will add you to the `rsi-help` list.
- `zrsihelpoff`: This will remove you from the `rsi-help` list.
- `zrsi`: Enter this command in your terminal to send Zephyr messages to the `rsi-talk` list. After pressing enter, you will be prompted to type your message.
- `zrsihelp`: This is analogous to the `zrsi` command, except it sends Zephyrs to the `rsi-help` list.

If you are using Barnowl (you can start this from the terminal by typing the command `barnowl`), you will normally be sending messages by typing “z” inside Barnowl, which will bring up the command “`zwrite`”. To send messages to the lists, type “`zwrite -c rsi-talk`” or “`zwrite -c rsi-help`”. (To send messages to a particular person, you would normally type “`zwrite user`”.)
