The Singapore-MIT Alliance (SMA) Graduate Fellowship at SMART provides:

- up to four years of **full tuition** at the student's home university;
- a monthly stipend of **S\$3,200**;
- an allowance of up to **S\$12,000** to help cover the expenses associated with a six month research residency at MIT;
- and **co-supervision** by an **MIT** and **NTU/NUS** faculty.

There is **no bond** associated with this fellowship.

In order to be eligible for an SMA Graduate Fellowship, a student must have:

- graduated with an undergraduate degree with first class or second-upper (or equivalent);
- a new doctoral student admitted to NTU or NUS;
- must have a research interest that fits within one or more of the projects currently being carried out in SMART Interdisciplinary Research Group (IRG)s:
 - ❖ *BioSystems and Micromechanics (BioSyM)*
 - ❖ *Center for Environmental Sensing and Modeling (CENSAM)*
 - ❖ *Infectious Diseases (ID)*
