I'm holding a poetry contest for poems specifically about the MIT experience. There is \$600 in cash prizes, plus selected poems will be published in a chapbook for graduation. The main goal is to get people talking about what it's like to go to MIT in a different way.

You'll note that my total requested budget is larger than my expected expenditures, but already I've learned that I won't be getting funding from the Council of the Arts.
