Shows breakfast prices

Many undergrads don't eat breakfast—about 50/50 overall. Small samples for Random, Bexley, NW, Senior House, and Faculty. Avg. price about 2-4 dollars

Table 047

Shows lunch prices

Similar small response sizes. Nearly all eat lunch. Prices more spread than breakfast, generally 3-8 \$.

Dinner prices (NO House Dining)

Most students eat dinner. Most prices \$3-9 with avg 5-7

Table 049

Dinner Prices (House Dining)

Most students eat dinner. Most prices \$3-6, avg \$4-5

Does this include membership?

Table 050 and 051 are late night prices (non HD/HD) but the responses do not show any correlation to dining with respect to HD membership numbers...I think that people got mixed up here. Too many HD members.

Dining program/style

Only well-represented dorms are FSILGS and HD Dorms...they have the obvious programs. Non HD Dorms did not have sufficient responses.

Faculty interest in student-interaction through dining

280 Responses; series of three yes/no questions. 63% interested in "Sit-down dining forums to interact with students", 63% interested in "Institute-sponsored events with food to interact with students", and 46% interested in "A meal in a residential dining room to interact with students"

Desired frequency of student interactive dining

Sit down + institute sponsored "often" or "occasionally" most popular..same with "meal in residential dining room" but that also has a strong "seldom"/"never" component

Table 055

(of faculty not interested in eating in dining hall)

Reason faculty does not want to dine in dining hall

**24 responses;** Select-multiple

Big reasons: Have not been invited (58%), Prefer to eat at home (54%), Did not know they were allowed to (38%), Not on campus after 5pm (38%).

Only minor responses to Not being comfortable visitng students in residences, not liking the food, or unappealing menus.

Table 057

(of faculty) how often do students eat in class

Less than 10% biggest (40%), then 10-25% (30%). About 12% do not allow food or have none.

#1 (30% ish) I think about making healthy eating choices, but do not always follow through with my intentions

#2 (15% ish) Throughout the day I eat a balanced diet consisting of grains, fruit, vegetables, dairy, meats, beans and oils

(students who live on campus)

Community and what meals should be offered

Students find meals an important part of residential life experience (75% avg)

Except for FSILG, most students don't think it is important for all house members to eat together

They also don't think it is important for all house members to participate in HD to support the cost

Next/McCormick/Baker/FSILGS want and would use (~50%) lunch @ their house, others reject idea

Students want breakfast (50-70%) except EC, Random, Senior House, and Grad Apartments
