Senate Funding Requests Overview

As the legislative branch of the Undergraduate Association, the UA Senate maintains the power to fund any student group at MIT out of two funding accounts – Senate Discretionary and the Fresh Fund. The Senate Discretionary fund can be allocated by the Senate throughout the semester towards any initiative, while the Fresh Fund is reserved for new student groups and projects that may not be able to take advantage of other funding cycles. There is \$10,000 per semester available in Senate Discretionary and \$3,000 per semester in the Fresh Fund.

To apply to either of these funds the group must use the respective application form on the UA website under the “Other Resources” tab. As well, the funding request must come in the form of a bill sponsored by a senator. The bill format appears on the UA website as well. Groups applying for funding must be in contact with a senator willing to sponsor their request in Senate.
