



42 U.A.S. 17.4

Bill to Create an Ad-Hoc Committee on Restructuring

Approved on April 25, 2011

Whereas there are multiple opinions and “proposals on how best to restructure the UA to meet the needs of the undergraduate body”¹; and

Whereas “large-scale changes affecting the structure of the UA,” “communication channels between the undergraduate student governments,” “and the roles and responsibilities of elected student representatives” “warrant thorough review”²; and

Whereas “it is the UA’s responsibility to ensure that any constitutional revision process is transparent[,] motivated toward a clear purpose,”³ and meets the demands of all concerned parties; and

Whereas an ad hoc UA committee with a faculty advisor would ensure proper communication with faculty and administrators;

Be it enacted, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:

That the UA establish an Ad Hoc Committee on Restructuring to examine the restructuring of the UA; and

That considerations of the committee include:

- Meeting with faculty and administrators to gather feedback on the UA restructuring
- Engaging directly with students to ask about what they see as the role of their student government
- Coming up with alternative proposals for the restructuring of student government
- Soliciting restructuring proposals from outside sources
- Communicating with students about competing proposals
- Deciding how to select and implement a final proposal.

That the committee consist of two delegates selected by Senate, the UA President-elect, a delegate from the IFC, a delegate from Panhel, three delegates from DormCon, a faculty facilitator selected by the UAP in lieu of a chair, and any additional undergraduate student members selected by the faculty facilitator.
