### Summary:

#### Police Action Policy:

Looking into a "Student Rights Pamphlet" - clarity of procedures for students

Looking into shifting policing model (seniority-based route choices vs. community policing)

Police Chief requested an advisory board consisting of faculty and students

#### Lobby 7 demonstrations:

Met with Noah and DSL

Main concern is communications (how, why, how the decisions are disseminated)

They met with Noah the night before

They want to resolve the issues quickly

They are interested in what are the actionable items?

President Hockfield will have monthly lunches
