# Resolution to Place Consistent Undergraduate Representation of Institute Task Force on Student Engagement

Whereas the Task Force for Student Engagement represents one of the few forums where student leaders may gather with upper level administration; and

Whereas proper student representation is key for the success of this committee; and

Whereas the time of the administrators is highly valued and finding a time that fits all member's schedule is challenging; and

Whereas the GSC has had consistent attendance, using all of their seats, and the undergraduate student body deserves similar representation; and

Whereas the representative from the UA has been the only undergraduate to attend in a consistent, reliable manner that promotes continuity and evolution of conversations;

**Be it resolved, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That the four Undergraduate seats be appropriated to students who will fully utilize them, for the benefit of student engagement as a whole; and

That ex-officio positions on the Task Force for Student Engagement be held by the UA President, UA Vice President and UA Senate Speaker; and

That that the fourth seat be assigned to a suitable, reliable member of the UA Senate (as necessary) as appointed by the UA President and approved by the UA Senate; and

That the other governments should engage these representatives with their concerns and be invited to TSE meetings that have substantial content directly relating to the other governments jurisdictions.
