# Bill to Reform UA Mailing Lists

Whereas the UA's mailing lists currently promote a lack of transparency, as members of Senate worry about inundating members of `ua-discuss@mit.edu` with mail; and

Whereas `ua-discuss` should be reserved for substantive discussions; and

Whereas the UA at times needs to disseminate confidential information;

**Be it enacted, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That `ua-senate` and `ua-exec` be renamed `ua-senate-members` and `ua-exec-members`, respectively; and

That lists `ua-senate-listeners` and `ua-exec-listeners` be created, open to any member of the UA; and

That lists `ua-senate` and `ua-exec` be created, containing the respective `-members` and `-listeners` lists; and

That mail sent to `-members` include a justification for its restriction to members of the applicable body; and

That mail sent to `-members` without such a justification should be responded to with a request for justification; and

That should no justification be provided within 24 hours, the email may be forwarded to `ua-senate` or `ua-exec`, as appropriate; and

That a summary of mail to `ua-senate-members` and `ua-exec-members` should be sent `ua-senate` or `ua-exec` at least monthly, and include a brief description of the topic and reason for confidentiality; and

That the Secretary-General ensure that these policies are followed, including by delegating the authority to enforce them; and

That `ua-senate` and `ua-exec` be archived, and these archives be made available to any member of this Association.
