# Bill to Create the Ad-Hoc UA Constitutional Committee

Whereas the wording of the UA Constitution, UA Senate Bylaws, and other governing documents has proven ambiguous in the past; and

Whereas the UA Constitution ought to provide a firm foundation upon which the entire Association can rely and depend; and

Whereas various aspects of the UA Constitution, Senate Bylaws, and other governing documents have not been consistently followed, and the reasons for these violations should be investigated;

**Be it resolved, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That the UA create an ad-hoc Constitutional Committee, charged with reviewing, clarifying, and revising the UA Constitution, UA Senate Bylaws, and other governing documents, while remaining true to the documents' original spirit; and

That the voting membership of the committee consist of the following officers:

- UA President
- UA Vice-President
- UA Senate Speaker
- UA Senate Vice-Chair
- UA Secretary-General
- UA Treasurer
- two representatives from the UA Senate (chosen by the Senate Speaker)
- a representative from the Class Councils (chosen by UA President)
- a representative from the Judicial Board (chosen by the Judicial Board Chair)
- ASA President ; and

That the committee shall be co-chaired by the UA President and the UA Senate Speaker; and

That the proceedings and minutes of this committee be thoroughly documented and publicly archived by the UA Secretary-General; and

That meetings of this committee be open to any member of the Association; and

That the committee shall frequently solicit input from the rest of the Association; and

That the committee's preliminary report and recommendations shall be submitted to the Association at the fourth regular Senate meeting of fall 2009.
